COMMON MISTAKES THAT THREATEN YOUR BEAUTIFUL, HEALTHY SMILE

MISTAKE #1: SPEED BRUSHING

It is extremely important to brush all of our tooth surfaces. It takes nearly 3 minutes to do this. Yet, most people spend less than 30 seconds brushing their teeth. In the process, they miss spots where bacteria are able to grow wild. Take your time when you brush and try to cover all of your tooth surfaces. Consider using a timer to make sure you brush for a full 3 minutes.

MISTAKE #2: NOT TAKING CARE OF YOUR TONGUE

Surprisingly, it may be your tongue that's causing embarrassing bad breath. People go through great effort to produce a sparkling set of teeth, but they ignore the tongue which is literally crawling with odor producing bacteria. To effectively remove these offending bacteria, consider one of several commercially available tongue cleaners (tongue scrapers). These simple devices, usually made of plastic or stainless steel, allow you to quickly remove bacteria, protein and food debris from your tongue, producing fresher, cleaner teeth.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON COLORADO COUNTY CENTRAL APPRAISAL DISTRICT BUDGET

The Colorado County CAD will hold a public hearing on the proposed budget for the 2008 fiscal year.

The public hearing will be held on August 14, 2007 at 3:30 p.m. in the Colorado County Central Appraisal District Board Room at 106 Cardinal Lane, Columbus, Texas.

A summary of the appraisal district budget follows. The total amount of the proposed budget is \$788,603. The amount of increase from the current year's budget is \$14,699.

The number of employees compensated under the proposed budget will be 10 employees.

The appraisal district is supported solely by payments from the local units served by the appraisal district.

If approved by the appraisal district board of directors at the public hearing, this proposed budget will take effect automatically unless disapproved by the governing bodies of the county, school districts, cities and towns served by the appraisal district.

A copy of the proposed budget is available for public inspection in the office of each of those governing bodies. A copy is also available for public inspection at the appraisal district office.
