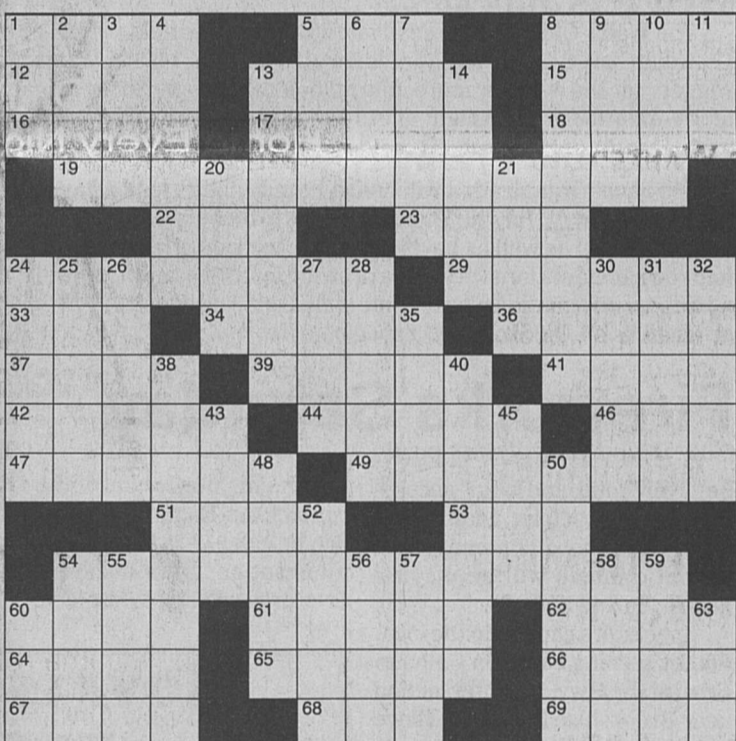

# Cool Off With A Delicious Ice Cream Treat

One of the great thrills of summer is getting to enjoy a refreshing helping of ice cream.

Whether it's in a cone or a cup, ice cream never fails when it comes to summertime refreshment.

Often times, trips to the local ice cream parlor are unplanned ways to fill some spare time and relieve the heat.

But thanks to best selling author Lou Seibert Pappas' "Ice

Creams & Sorbets: Cool Recipes" (Chronicle Books), those lazy, hazy days of summer can be spent making your own ice cream as a cool alternative to heading outside.

Those looking to try their hand at becoming an amateur dessert chef this summer should round up the kids and take a crack at the following recipe for the classic Mexican desert "Dulce de Leche Ice Cream."

### DULCE DE LECHE ICE CREAM

- Makes About 1 Quart
- 2 cups half-and-half or milk
  - 4 large egg yolks
  - 1/2 cup sugar
  - 2 cups (12 ounces) butterscotch chips, divided
  - 1 cup heavy (whipping) cream
  - 1 teaspoon vanilla extract

Prepare a large bowl or pan of ice water.

In the top of a double boiler, heat the half-and-half over simmering water until steaming.

In a bowl, whisk the egg yolks until blended, then whisk in the sugar.

Whisk in about half of the hot half-and-half and pour the yolk mixture into the pan of half-and-half.

Stir with a silicone spatula or

spoon and cook over simmering water for about 8 minutes.

Stir in 1 cup of the chips and continue stirring until blended in and the custard coats the back of the spatula, about 2 minutes more.

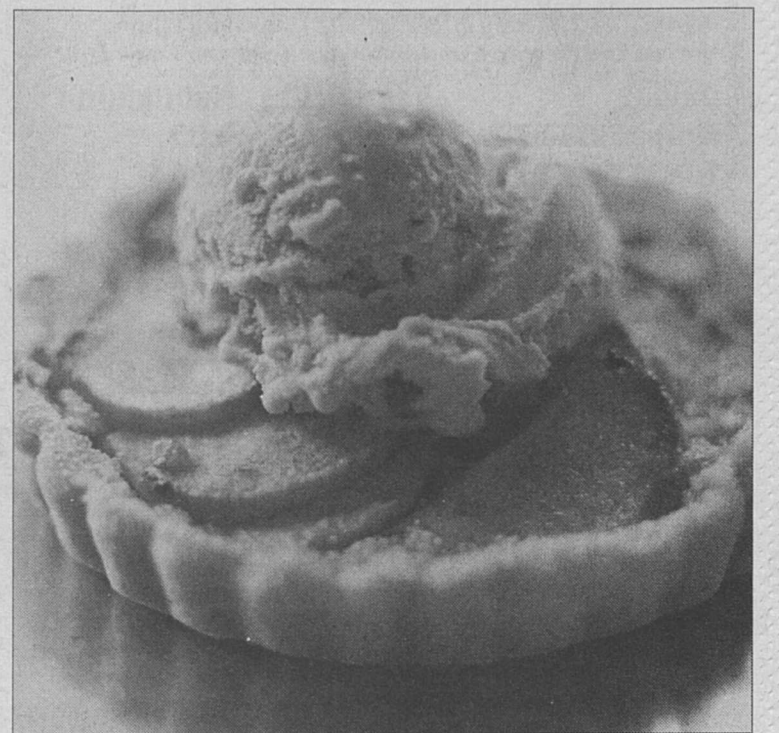
Immediately place the custard pan in the ice bath and stir the custard occasionally until it cools to room temperature.

Transfer to a container and stir in the cream and vanilla. Cover and refrigerate until thoroughly chilled, about 3 hours.

Freeze in an ice cream maker according to the manufacturer's instructions.

When the ice cream is almost frozen, add the remaining 1 cup chips and churn until blended in, about 15 seconds more.

Transfer to a container, cover and freeze until firm, about 2 hours.
