Austin Road in regards to a loose cow. The cow had moooved on by the time Wilson arrived.

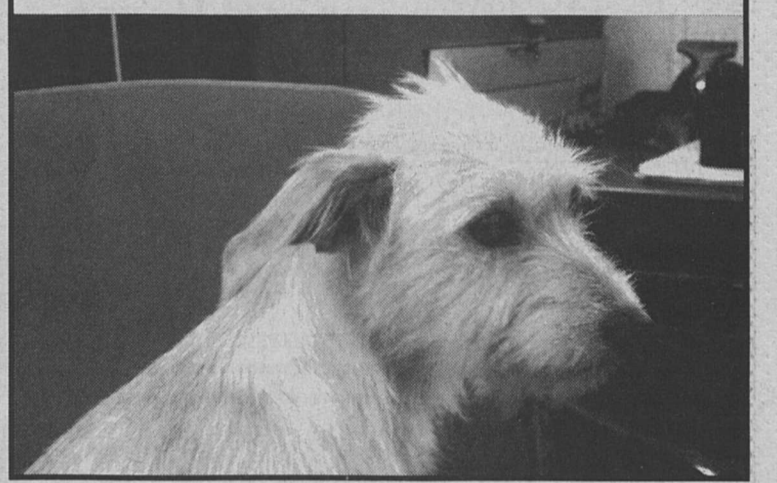

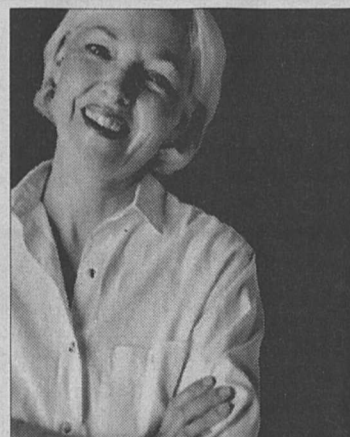
