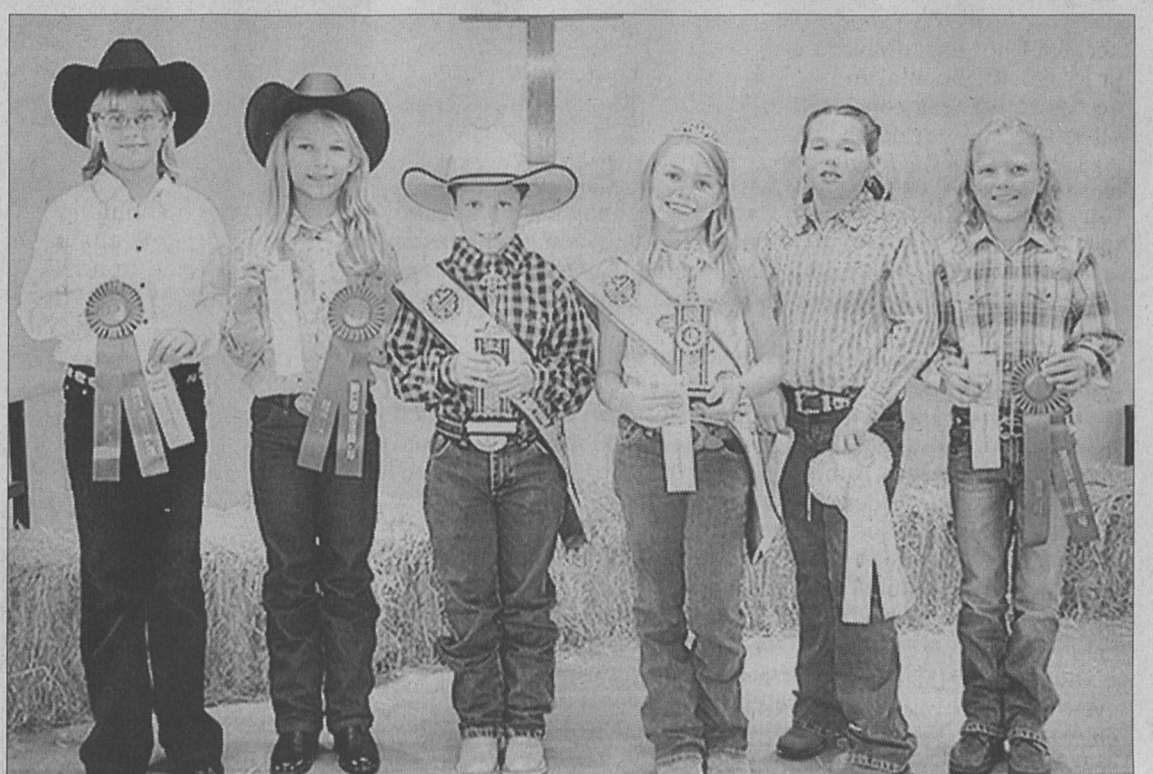
Star of Texas Fair and Rodeo Calf Scramble deadline to the Extension office is September 21, 2007 - please contact the Extension Office for signing up.
