25-19, 26-25.

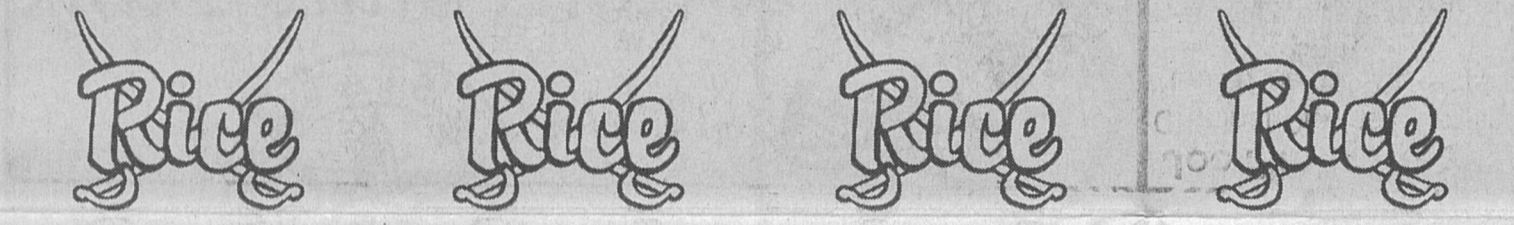
The Lady Raiders faced Needville for the third match of the tournament but came up short 23-25, 22-25. The last match was for a third place trophy against Columbus.
