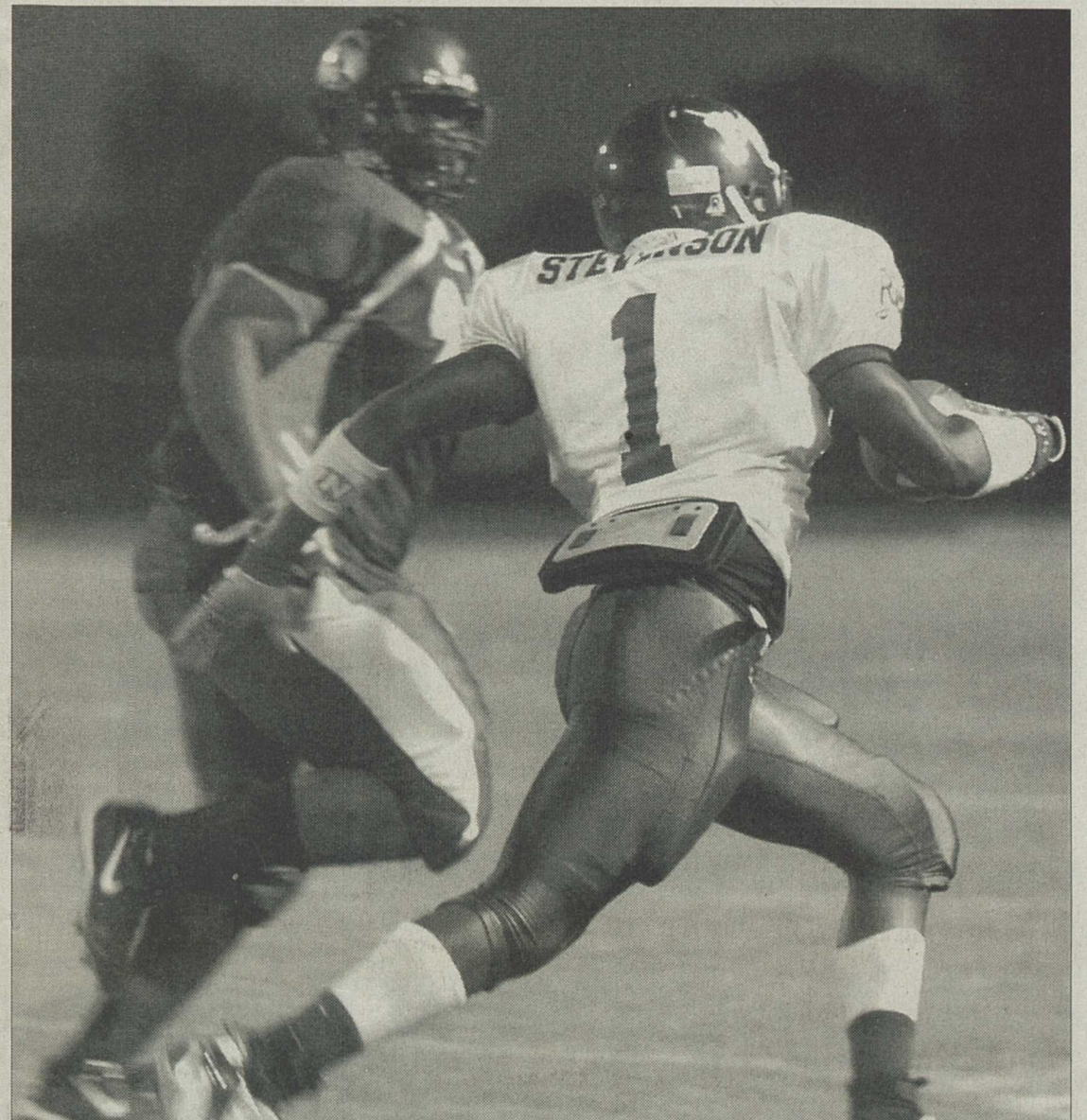


Austin Moore wraps-up the Weimar quarterback as the Raider defense closes in.

Raiders Move To 4-0 With Victory Over Weimar On Friday Night

no good making the score 13-0 with 8:04 left in the opening stanza.

The Raider defense stepped up and forced Weimar to go three and out and Arrison got a hand on the Weimar punt giving the Raiders excellent field position at the Weimar 42 to start their second drive.

Foster carried for four, then nine yards to the 29.

After a holding penalty and an incomplete pass, Cook threw to Marquis Toliver for a 14-yard gain to the 25-yard line.

A fumble on the next play stopped the Raider drive.

Weimar was again forced three and out, but pressure on the punt attempt from Arrison forced

Weimar to throw a pass instead of kicking and gave Rice the ball at the Weimar 26.

After a three-yard loss on first down, Foster cut through the Wildcat defense for another Rice touchdown.

Cook threw to Toliver for the two-point conversion and a 21-0 lead with 2:17 left in the first quarter.

Weimar drove the ball to the Rice 46 on their next possession where they faced a fourth down and two.

The Wildcats decided to go for it and after lining-up in a goal line type offense, faked the run and lobbed a short pass over the Raider defense for a 46-yard touchdown.

The extra point was good, making the score 21-7 with 11:07 left in the first half.

The Raiders got good field position again at the Rice 47 to start their drive and made short work of things.

Foster carried once for seven yards to the Weimar 46, then broke free again, this time for a 46-yard touchdown.

The extra point was no good after a snap miscue and the score was 27-7 with 10:11 left in the half.

Weimar pushed the ball close to midfield with their next possession but was forced to punt.

The punt was muffed and Weimar recovered deep in Raider territory at the 23.

The Raiders took the ball back on the very next play when Petus intercepted a pass attempt at their own four-yard line.

After an incomplete pass on first down, the Raiders put the ball back into Foster's hands.

He again got through the line into the secondary and weaved his way through the Weimar defense for a spectacular 93-yard run before being dragged down at the Weimar three-yard line.

Foster got the payoff three plays later when he punched through for his third trip to pay dirt.

A two point try was no good, making the score 33-7 with 6:16 left in the first half.

The Wildcats moved the ball

only a short distance on their next drive, but were forced to punt the ball away.

Rice fumbled the ball two plays later and again gave Weimar great field position at the 26.

The Wildcats completed two passes to reach the end zone and after the extra point the score was 33-14 with just over 2 minutes left in the half.

Rice took over in good position at their own 42, and Cook threw for 8 yards to midfield on first down.

Weeks got the handoff on the next play and blazed through the Wildcat defense for a 50-yard score.

Samaniego's extra point was good making the score 40-14 with 2:03 on the clock.

The Raiders got the ball to open the second half and needed only three plays to get back into the end zone.

After a 52-yard run by Foster, Williams got through the line for a 15-yard score.

Samaniego hit the extra point for a 47-14 lead with just 51 seconds gone in the half.

The Wildcats got another touchdown later in the third quarter on a three-yard run that capped a 39-yard drive.

Rice added one more score on an 18-yard run by Kaley that finished off a three-play, 52-yard drive. A failed two-point conversion made the score 53-21 in favor of the Raiders.
