Thomas, Upson family reunion Oct. 27

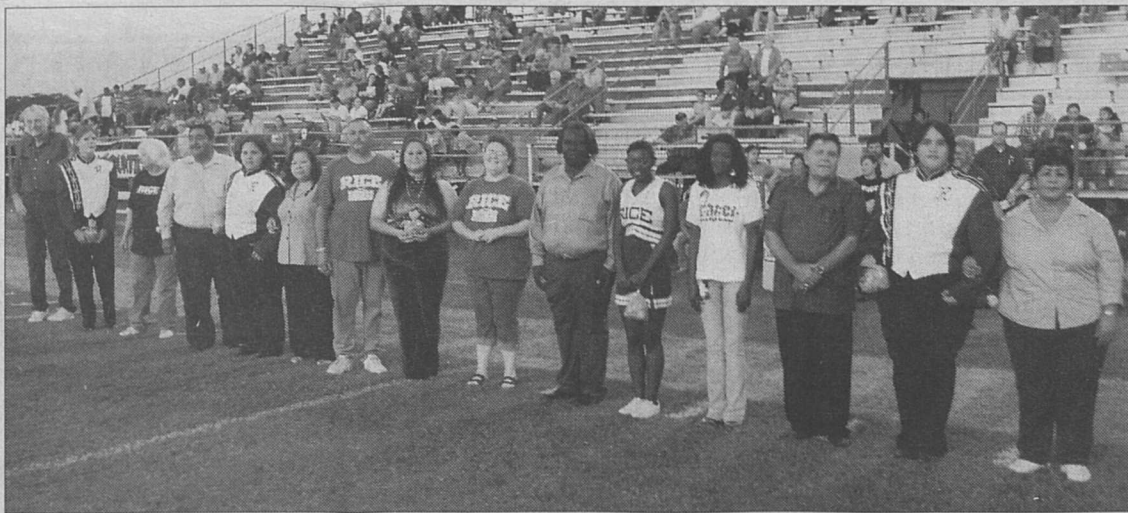

Multi-Year reunion planned

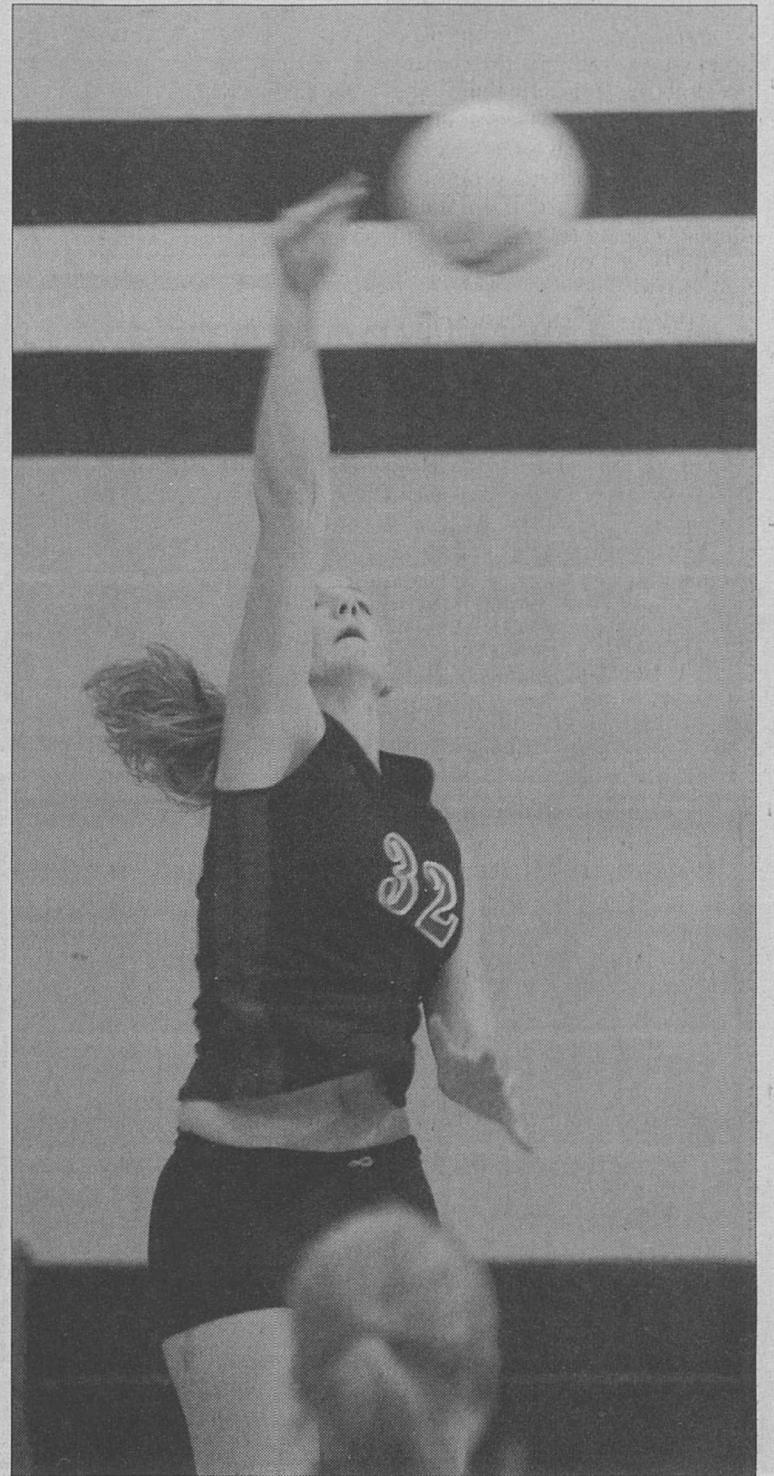
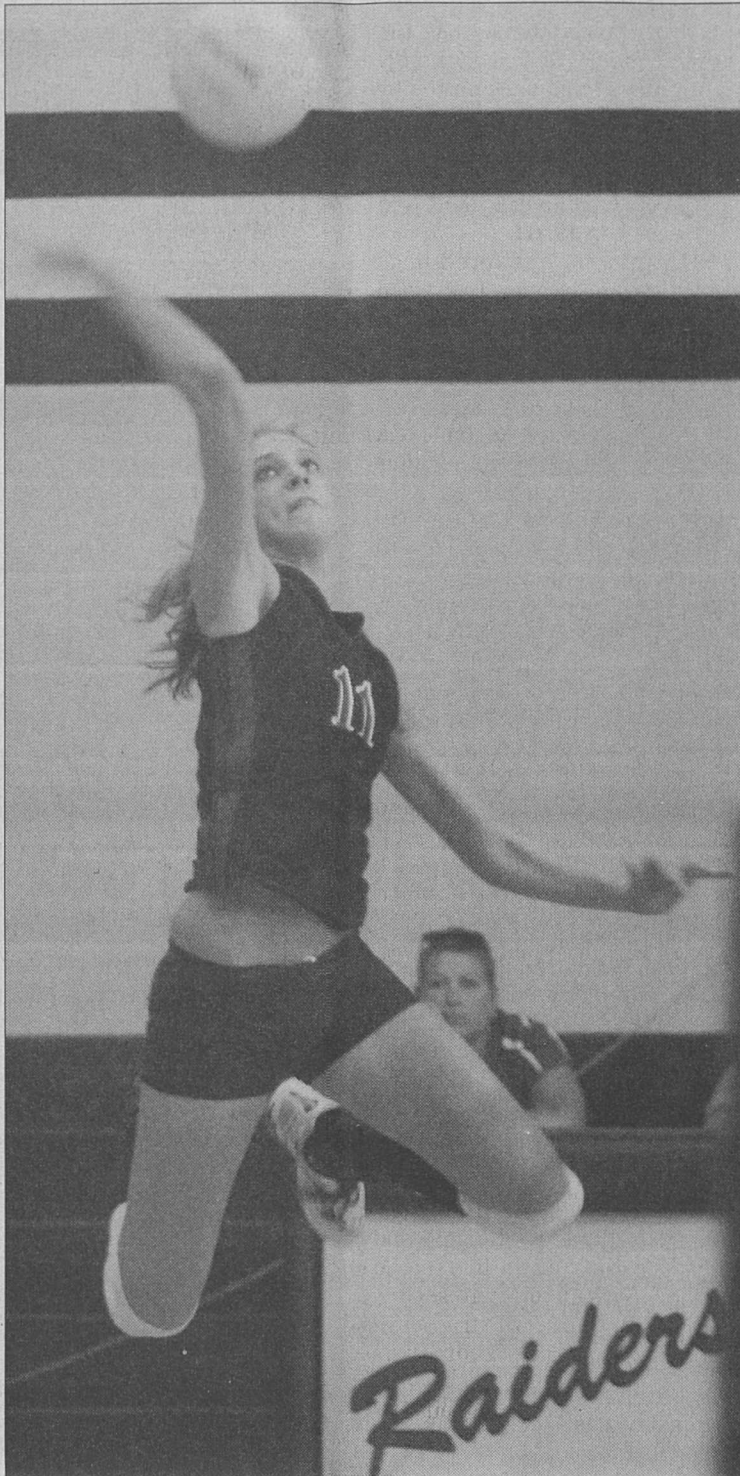

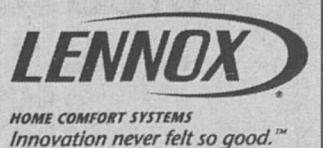
