

JV Raiders Tie With Tidehaven

This past Thursday the Rice JV football team battled Tidehaven's JV to a 20-20 tie.

In the first half of the game Rice's offense moved the ball down inside the Tiger's 20-yard line twice before stalling out and turning the ball over on downs. The Raider's defense stopped the Tiger's offense the first half, and the half time score was 0-0.

All of Rice's scoring for the game came in the third quarter and Tidehaven scored twice in the third and once in the fourth.

Tidehaven scored first after the Raiders fumbled the football on their first possession in the third quarter, making the score 8-0. Johnny Castaneda took the ensuing kick off and returned it for a touchdown. The extra point try failed making the score 6-8 in favor of Tidehaven.

The next time the Raiders have the ball they fumbled on their own 22 yard line and the Tigers were able to score another touchdown and make the score 6-14.

The Raiders came back after this and scored another touch-

down of their own on a run by Michael Scott.

The next Tiger possession ended when Michael Scott intercepted a pass and turned it for the Raider's third touchdown of the third quarter. The extra point was good when Tramayne Tillman connected on a pass with Kevin Ellis. This made the score 20-14 and the first time in the game that the Raiders had the lead.

The Raiders gave up one more touchdown to the Tigers in the fourth quarter. The Tigers scored on a 70-yard pass play but the Raiders held them on the extra point making the final score 20-20.

This game is the only mar on Raiders season thus far and their record now is five wins, no losses and one tie. The defense played well as Tim Morales, Eric Gold and Jacob Munoz all had sacks for the night and Scott intercepted a pass and recovered a fumble for the Raiders.

The Raiders next opponent is Schulenburg this coming Thursday at 6 p.m. in the "Swamp".

The Lady Raiders varsity volleyball team won two in a row against Ganado and Tidehaven.

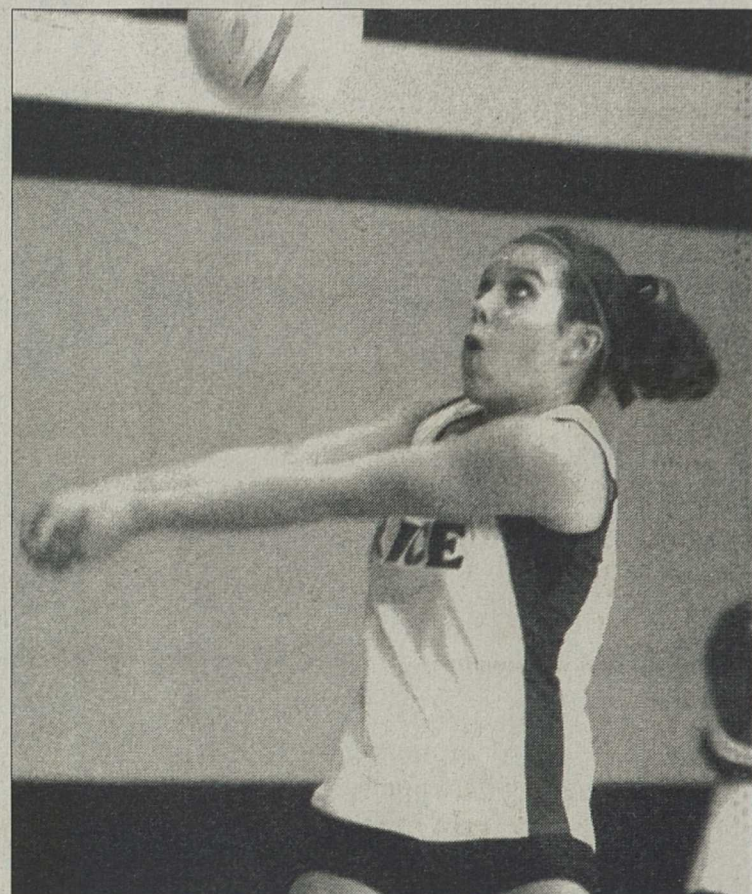
Scores for the Ganado game were 25-25, 25-10 and 25-15.
