This Notice shall satisfy the above-cited two separate but related procedural notification requirements.

REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS

On or about 11/11/2007 the City of Eagle Lake will submit a request to the Office of Rural Community Affairs (ORCA) for the release of Texas Community Development Block Grant funds under Title I of the Housing and Community Development act of 1974 (P.L. 93-383), as amended, to undertake a project known as 727129, for the purpose of rehabilitating and upgrading the existing 300,000 and 500,000 gallon ground storage tanks; installing approximately 250 linear feet of 8" sewer line, 135 linear feet of 4" service line, 1 manhole, and related tie-ins, service wyes and pavement repair at Norris Ave. from State St to 1/2 block north of State St.; US Highway 90A (W of Stevenson) and alley between Davitt St and Union St (E of Cemetery) at sites of existing storage. We considered the environmental impact of both construction and service provision within the described construction zone, the service area, and adjacent areas up to 1/2 mile from the construction zone that could be affected by the project.

FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT

The City of Eagle Lake has determined that the project will have no significant impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) is not required. Additional project information is contained in the Environmental Review Record (ERR) on file at the City of Eagle Lake City Hall, 100 East Main Street, Eagle Lake, Texas 77434-0038 and may be examined or copied weekdays from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Any individual, group, or agency disagreeing with this determination or wishing to comment on the project may submit written comments to the Office of the Mayor. All comments received by 11/10/2007 will be considered by the City of Eagle Lake prior to authorizing submission of a request for release of funds. Commentors should specify which part of this Notice they are addressing.

RELEASE OF FUNDS

The City of Eagle Lake certifies to ORCA that Mike Morales in his capacity as Mayor brought to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. ORCA approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities, and allows the City of Eagle Lake to use Program funds.

OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

ORCA will consider objections to its release of funds and the City of Eagle Lake certification received by 11/26/2007 or a period of fifteen days from its receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer or other officer of the City of Eagle Lake approved by ORCA (b) the City of Eagle Lake has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR Part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the project have committed funds or incurred costs not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by ORCA; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58) and shall be addressed to The Office of Rural Community Affairs at P.O. Box 12877, Austin, Texas 78711. Potential objectors should contact ORCA to verify the actual last day of the objection period.
