This year's live auction will include items such as a framed No. 1 giclee from local artist Ken Turner; a Beckey Zajicek original oil painting framed by The Custom Shoppe; Wade Schindler's cooking lessons for 10 at the buyer's home; a champagne brunch for 20 at Mostyn's Crossing; a Tracy Hanak/Patricia Wicke spa and fitness weekend for 4 ladies at The Falls; and a Jack Greenwade etched sterling cuff bracelet.

The 2005 event netted almost \$20,000 for YFS and since this year will add Friday night shopping, refreshments and bucket raffle, it is anticipated the amount will be even greater.

Cook Urges Voter Participation

State Representative Robby Cook (D-Eagle Lake) encourages voters to go to the polls on Nov. 6 to vote on 16 proposed amendments to the Texas Constitution.

Rep. Cook announced that his office can provide voters with an informative summary of the proposed amendments to help local citizens analyze the choices.

"The voters of Texas have the final say in amending our state constitution," said Rep. Cook.

"So, I want to give the voters every opportunity to understand the proposed amendments.

That way we can make the right decisions for the future of Texas."

"I am pleased to offer a booklet, free of charge, which has analyses of the 16 proposed amendments.

This booklet provides a summary of each amendment, along with arguments for and against the amendment," explained Rep. Cook.

"The booklet has been prepared by the Texas Legislative Council, which is a non-partisan legislative agency."

"That's why it's important for voters to know what they're being asked to vote on before they cast their ballot."
