# Texas Crop Weather Report

For the week of Nov. 9  
The 2007 Texas Upland cotton crop is expected to total 8.1 million bales, up 40 percent from 2006 and up 8 percent from last month, according to the Texas Field Office.

Yield is expected to average 827 pounds per acre, up 61 pounds from last month and 148 pounds more than a year ago.

Objective yield measurements in Texas for November show bolls per acre and boll weight are the largest on record, reported State Director David Abbe.

Corn production is forecast at 285 million bushels, up 62 percent from last year's production and up 4 percent from last month.

Based on November 1 conditions, statewide yield is expected to average 150 bushels per acre, 29 bushels more than in 2006 and up 6 bushels from last month.

Texas peanut production, at 629 million pounds, is up 22 percent from last year.

Statewide yield, at 3,400 pounds per acre, is down 150 pounds from last year and unchanged from last month.

Sorghum production is forecast at 96.8 million hundredweight, up 177 percent from last year and up 4 percent from last month.

Yield, at 4,032 pounds per acre, is up 1,344 pounds from last year and up 168 pounds from last month.

Rice production is forecast at

9.8 million cwt, down 9 percent from 2006 and down 1 percent from last month.

Yield is forecast at 6,700 pounds per acre, down 470 pounds from a year ago and down 100 pounds from last month.

The 2007 Texas soybean crop is forecast at 2.7 million bushels, down 27 percent from last year's production and up 6 percent from last month's forecast.

Yield is expected to average 34 bushels per acre, up 10 bushels from last year and up 2 bushels from last month.

United States' corn production is forecast at 13.2 billion bushels, up 25 percent from last year's crop and down 1 percent from last month.

A yield of 153 bushels per acre is forecast, up 3.9 bushels from last year and down 1.7 bushels from last month.

The sorghum crop is up 85 percent from last year to 288.2 million cwt.

The U.S. Upland cotton crop is expected to total 18.1 million bales, down 13 percent from last year, and up 4 percent from October.

Soybean production is forecast at 2.59 billion bushels, down 19 percent from last year, and down slightly from last month.

The U.S. peanut crop is estimated at 3.47 billion pounds, up marginally from a year ago. U.S. rice production is forecast at 198 million cwt, up slightly from October and up 2 percent from 2006.
