## TAX TIPS from RAY

Penalty For Under Withholding Or Under-Estimating  
One way to avoid a penalty for failing to pay or withhold sufficient income taxes for a tax year is to pay 100% of your prior years tax liability in quarterly estimated payments or through withholding. Planning Alert! If your 2006 AGI was over \$150,000, you must pay in 110% of your 2006 tax liability to qualify for this safe harbor in 2007. Tax Tip. If have not paid sufficient estimates to avoid an underpayment penalty for 2007, you may have additional amounts withheld from your wages, year-end bonuses, or IRA distributions on or before December 31, 2007. Any withholding for 2007 is deemed paid equally on each quarterly installment date, even if the withholding occurs in December.
