So be careful with young children learning to brush their teeth. Parents should limit them to a small dab of toothpaste and teach them to spit out the paste, not swallow it. Don't forget that flouride occurs naturally in brewed tea, canned fish, cooked kale and spinach, apples and skim milk.
