The Mixed Doubles duo lost their first round match to Morrow/Farris of Cuero, 5-8 but then came back strong to win three matches in a row to garner the championship.

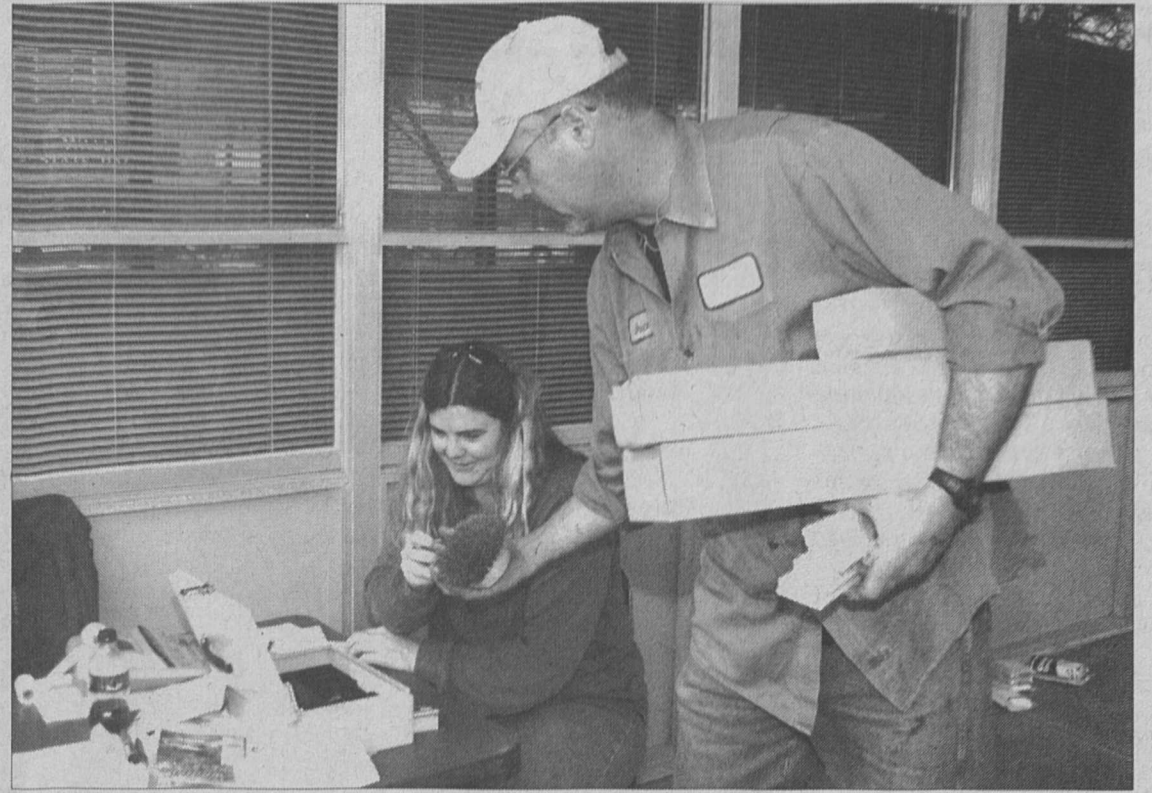

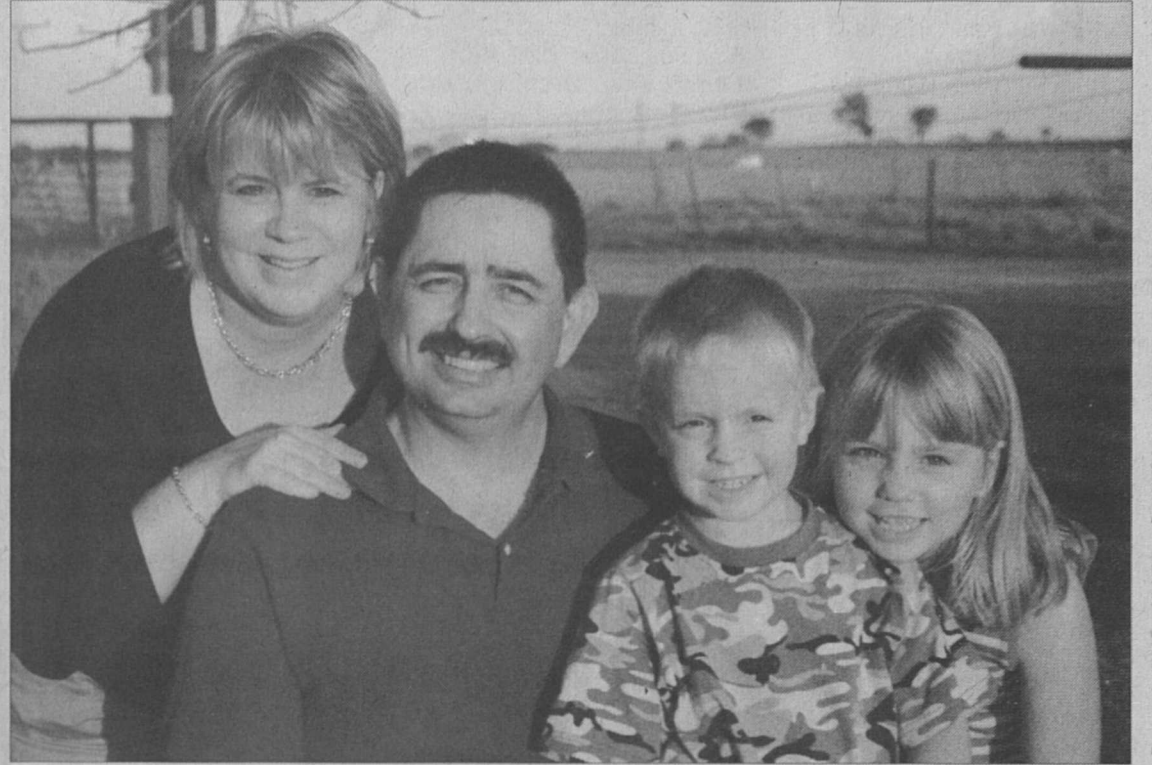

Come out and watch some great Tennis!



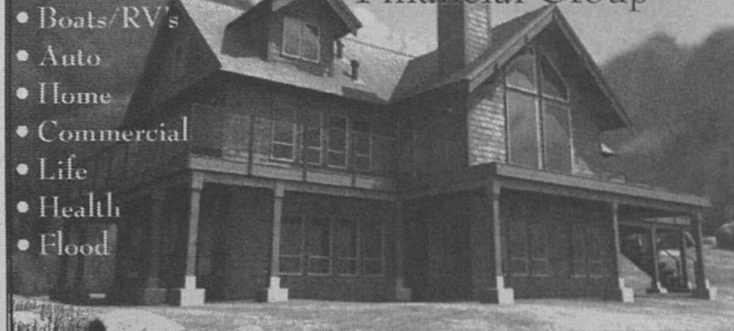
