## Wal-Mart Donates To Family Crisis Center

Miriam Moerbe, RN, BSN is the Wesley Nurse serving the residents of Colorado County. Miriam knew that there were individuals and families in need in her area, but she was looking for specific items that would help in the utmost manner. She went to the Family Crisis Center in Columbus and spoke with Yvonne Rodriguez, Family Crisis Center Advocate to see exactly what the underserved community needed most. The answer was clear and precise - HEAT. According to Yvonne there were many families who were using unsafe forms of heat to stay warm in the winter. Miriam took the idea to her Health & Wellness Committee at the First United Methodist Church. One of the members, a pharmacist at Wal-Mart, suggested that she speak to Wal-Mart for a possible donation. Miriam made contact with Mary Salinas, Wal-Mart Personnel Manager who worked with her to secure a donation to assist the Family Crisis Center. 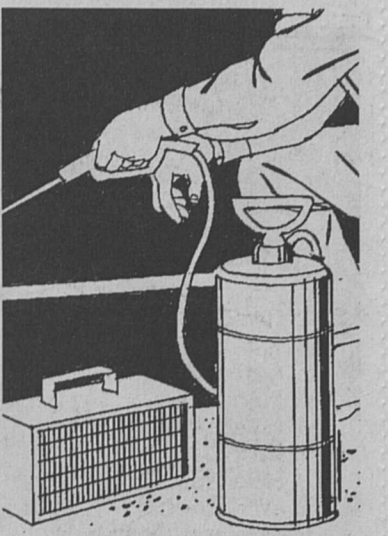
