4-H Summer Day Camps Slated

Two day camps, sponsored by the Colorado County 4-H Council, have been planned for June, 2008. Both camps will be held from 8:30 a.m. till 4:30 p.m.

Camps will have limited space and will be filled on a first come first serve basis. Participants will need to bring a sack lunch, but drinks and snacks will be provided. The camps are open to all youth in Colorado County.

Leather working - will be held on Monday, June 16 at the Colorado County Ag Building. Barbara Martinek of Oakleaf Leather Works will conduct the workshop.

Participants will have the opportunity to go home with a completed leather project that will be eligible to show in the Handicraft division of the Colorado County Fair.

Cost for the day camp will be \$10 and the deadline to sign up

and pay the fee is May 30, 2008.

Clothing - A sewing day camp has been scheduled for June 23-26, 2008 at the Colorado County Ag Building. Each participant will have the opportunity to construct an alphabet pillow or their initials or name.

They will need 1/2 yard of 36" or 45" material per pillow plus matching thread. The second project participants will have the opportunity to construct will be a pair of shorts, skirt or Capri pants.

For this project you will need to purchase one of the following patterns and the required amount of material, elastic, thread and any other notions required.

The pattern numbers include: McCalls M3193, M8934, or M5357 and Simplicity 7655, 3799, 9958,

3743, 4206, or 9607. If time allows, participants will have the opportunity to construct a tote bag. For this project you will need 3/4 yard of material for bag, 3/4 yard of lining material and 1 3/8 yard of interfacing.

The pillow and tote bag patterns will be provided for your use. Participants that have their own sewing machines may bring them to use.

A limited number of machines will be provided for use. The deadline to sign up is June 13, 2008.

Individuals with disabilities who require an auxiliary aid, service or accommodation in order to participate in any Extension Activities, are encouraged to contact the County Extension Office for assistance eight days prior to the activity.
