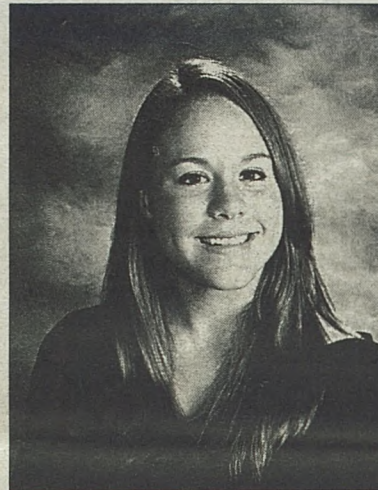

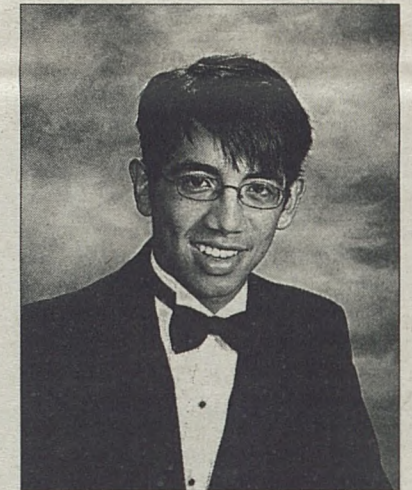
Project (10-12) placing 4th in Heavy Weight Class (10,11) and 1st in Medium Weight Class (12) at the Colorado County Fair.
