



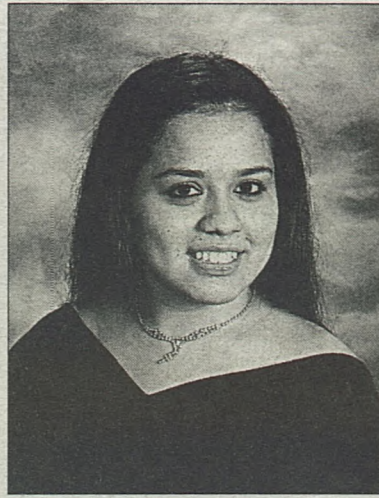
Sandy M. Preather

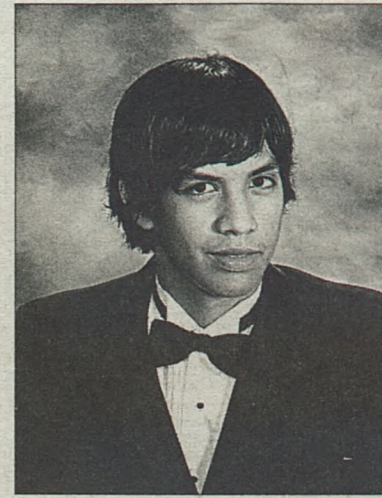


Anacaren Rivera

...son of Javier and Alicia Salinas of Eagle Lake.

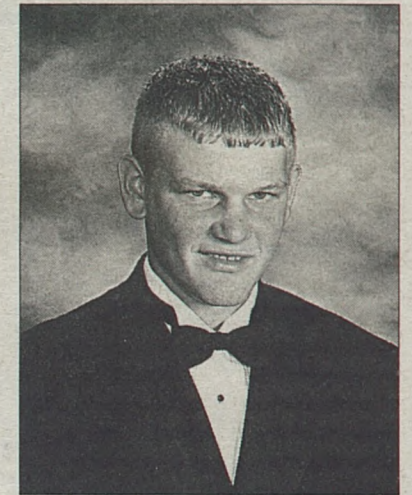
Nicholas participated in varsity track and cross-country, all four years.

Adam Dane Shimek

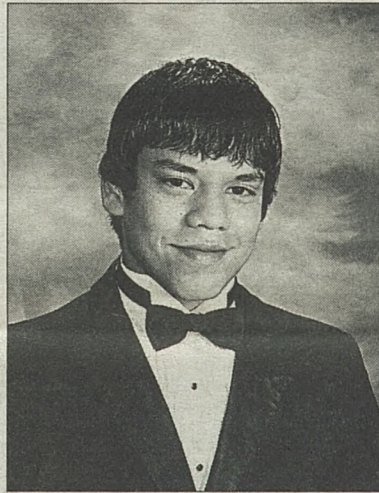
...son of Al and Martha Shimek of Garwood.

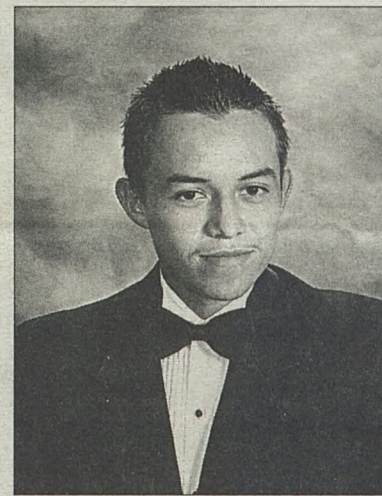


Sergio Omar Rodriguez

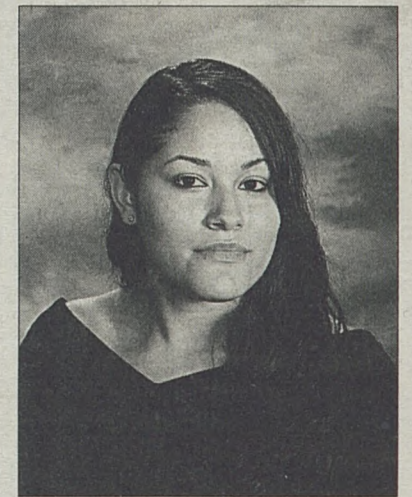


Luis Samaniego

After graduation he plans to attend Wharton County Junior College for his basics.

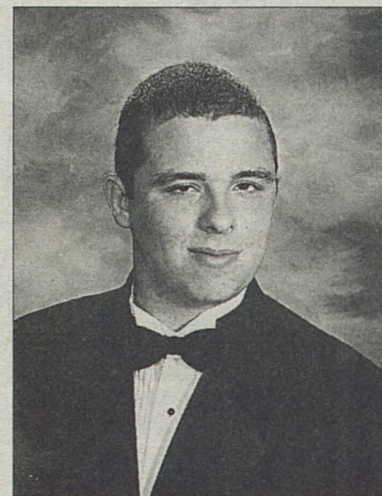


Esmeralda Sotelo

She plans to attend Wharton County Junior College to become a surgical technician.



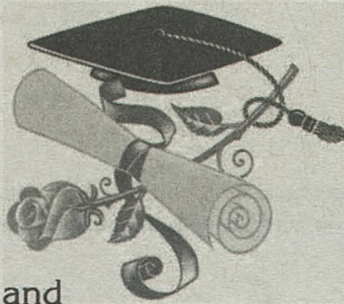
