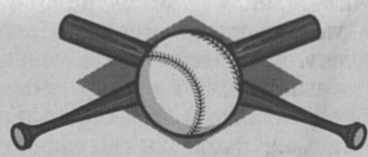

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON COLORADO COUNTY GROUNDWATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT BUDGET

The Colorado County Groundwater Conservation District will hold a public hearing on the proposed budget for the 2008 fiscal year.

The public hearing will be held on **Wednesday, June 18, 2008 at 7:00 p.m. at Columbus City Hall**

Columbus, Texas.

A summary of the groundwater conservation district budget follows:
The total amount of the proposed budget is \$272,565.
There was no budget for the district in 2007.

The number of employees compensated under the proposed budget will be three employees.

The groundwater conservation district shall be supported by tax revenues.

If approved by the groundwater conservation district board of directors at the public hearing, this proposed budget will take effect automatically unless it exceeds .03 per \$100 of valuation.
