## Raiders Advance To State In 7-On-7

The Rice Raiders 7-on-7 football team has advanced to the State Tournament by winning three out of four games at a recent tournament in Cuero.

The Raiders won three games in pool play before losing to Giddings in the championship game.

Giddings and Rice each clinched a berth in the state tournament, which is scheduled for July 10-11 at Texas A&M in College Station.

Rice started the tournament with a 28-20 overtime win against

Cuero, won 18-6 over Palacios and beat La Villa 20-19.

"We played 7-on-7 for the first time last year and I think we learned from that," Rice Coach Brad Dumont said. "We prepared by playing a bunch of games and did a little better."

The Raiders' defense was its

strong suit, which created turnovers and was stingy inside its 15-yard line.

"I thought we did well," said linebacker Damien Stevens, who had two interceptions. "It's tough not being able to bump somebody. I just tried to read the quarterback and break on the ball."
