This was the fourth year that Living Hope used alumni of the Vacation Bible School to guide the children between activities and assist in the various centers.

The guides were Jaquita Woods, Stephanie Castillo, Jeslyn Cantu and Keshlie Perez. Games director Vandermark is also a multi year VBS alumni.

SonWorld Adventure Park was the theme of the VBS. The theme taught principles of Choice from Jesus' healing miracles of the gospels. The children learned that We can Choose to Believe (from the story of Blind Bartimaeus, Choose to Act (from the story of the 10 lepers), Choose Forgiveness (from the story of the paralytic carried by his four friends), Choose to Obey (from the story of the Rich Young Ruler), and Choose Jesus (from the story of Thomas). Elaborate decorations and wonderful games and crafts were enjoyed by all.

Pastor Fling commented, "All of the credit to this marvelous program goes to our teachers and workers. Each year we have workers who use vacation time from their jobs to be able to make

this voluntary investment of their time in these youngsters."

The opening assembly and music were tremendous times of celebration as the children came together. Pastor Mercy Fling said, "Every year we learn marvelous, catchy new songs that stay with the children and adults for years to come."

Five fun filled days concluded on Friday with the SonWorld Adventure Park Celebration, a closing assembly where each class performed a group song and awards were given. C.
