The bride-elect grandparents are Kenneth and Alice Young and the late Raymond and Edna Wrobliski, all of Rosenberg.

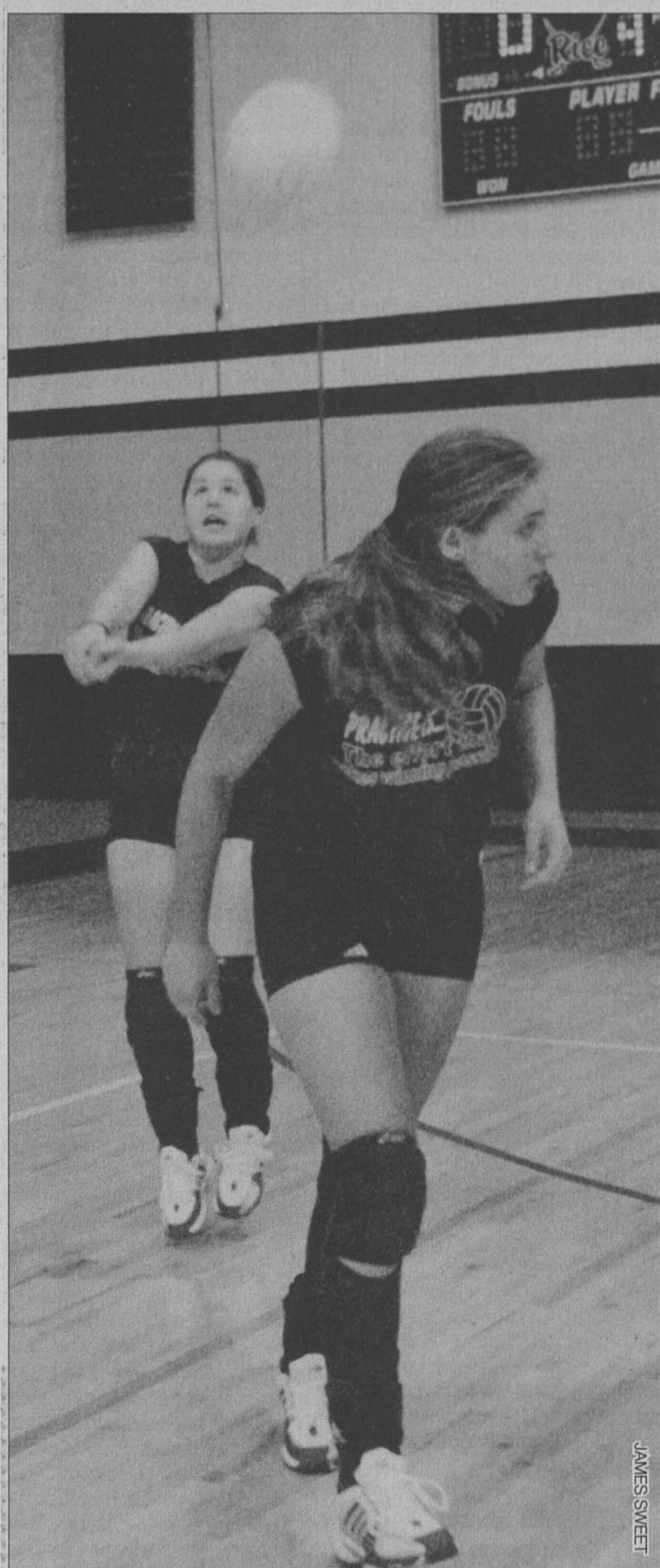
Gus is a 2001 graduate of Rice Consolidated High School and is employed by BAE (formerly Stewart and Stevenson) in Sealy, as a welder II.

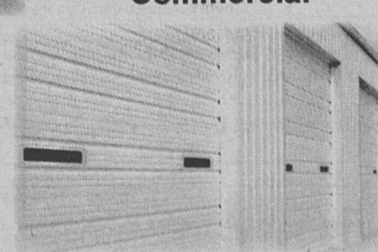
