she felt the proposed raises of 5 percent for cost of living and 2 percent merit, were "substantial" and said a number of taxpayers are not getting similar increases.

Another resident, Bob Berger, said he felt that county employees needed a significant pay raises and pointed to rising costs.

County Judge Al Jamison later criticized Mrs. Raborn and her husband, Bob, saying he had listened to them for 10 years.

"All I've heard is complaints," he said.

In other action, commissioners:

—Appointed Dr. Donna Campbell as the county's local health authority.

—Voted not to hold an election on whether to abolish the post of county surveyor.

The post is currently vacant, but is open for candidate filing.

One individual, Matt Loessin, said he planned to file as a candidate.

County commissioners noted that the position receives no salary or compensation from the county.

—Approved renewal of an agreement with the law firm of
