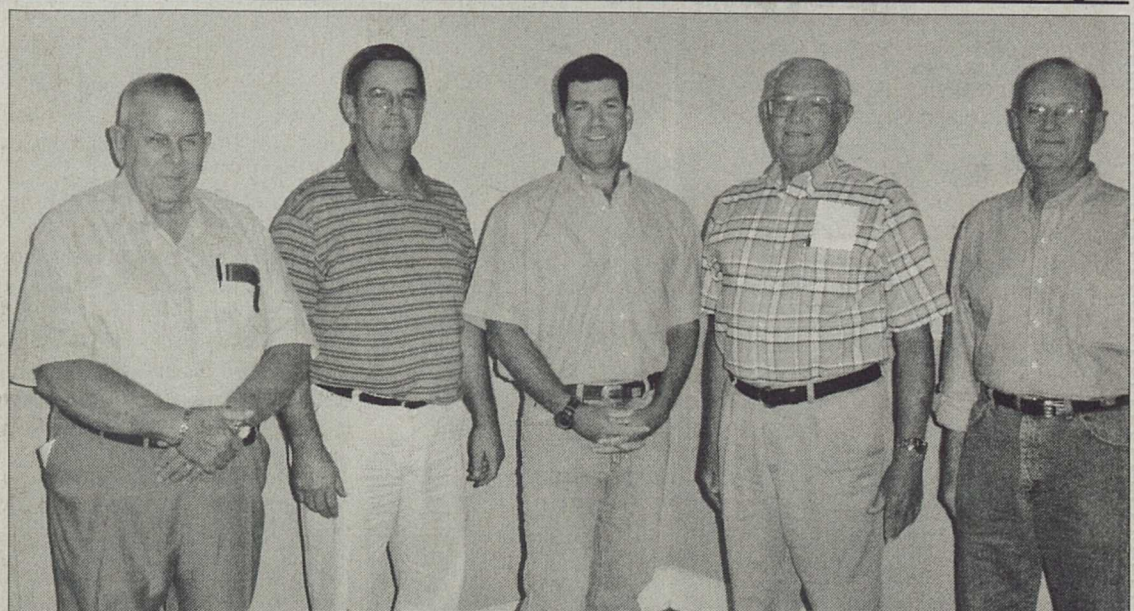




Reserve Champion Broilers

Five Lawsuits Filed in County

Five lawsuits were filed in Colorado County District Court in the past week.

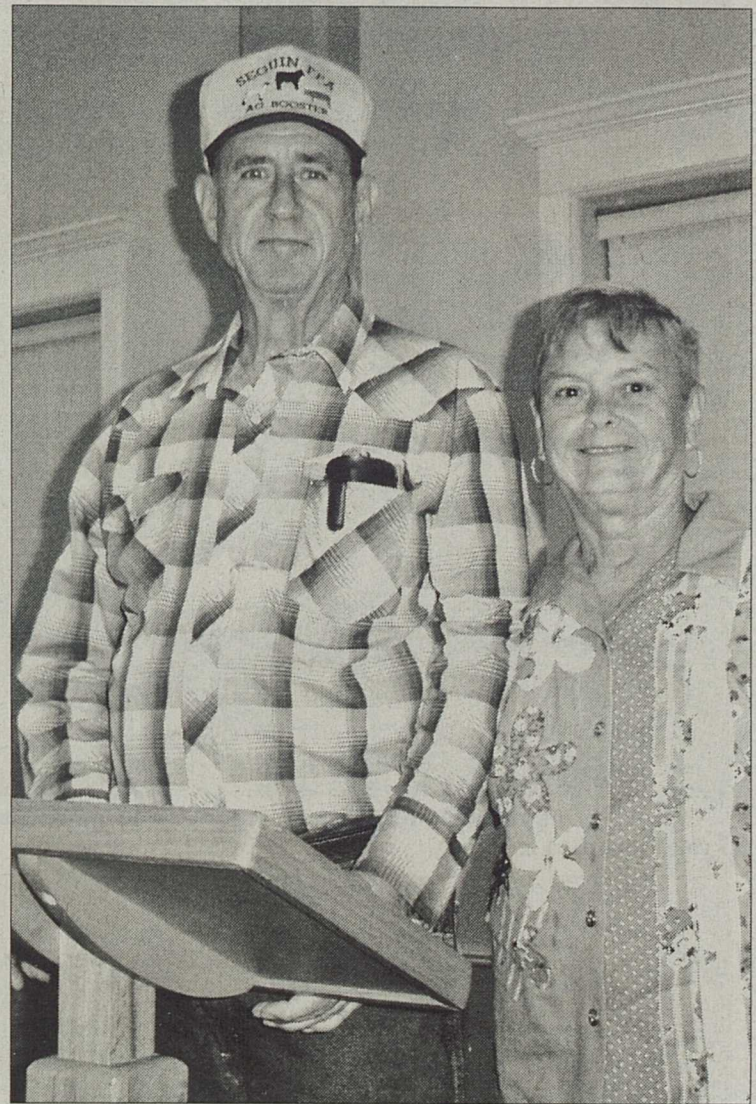
On Sept. 22, Doris Wilma Bishop and Lovey Bishop filed suit against Green Tree Servicing LLC in a dispute over property at 418 North Eagle in Weimar.

The suit disputes a foreclosure action by Green Tree and claims that Doris and Lovey Bishop are only two of seven owners of the property.

On Sept. 22, Marek's Service Inc. filed suit against Charles Sowell in a dispute over payment on an account for dirt excavation. The amount in dispute is \$38,510.

Also on Sept. 22, Green Tree Servicing filed suit against Tina Schrader and Joe Schrader in a dispute over possession of a house. The suit claims that Tommy Parker purchased the property through a loan and transferred possession of the property to the Schraders. The suit is seeking possession of the

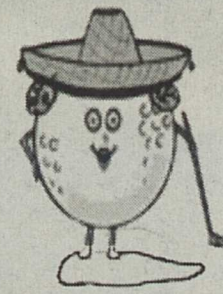
