

County Commissioners Table Action On Repair Bid

Commissioners discussed awarding the bid at their meeting in November. Hutson said he had some questions about one of the projected subcontractors for the project and he wanted to get more

information in that area.

Once work is started, the project has a completion date of 335 calendar days.

In other action, commissioners:

--Were told that the Lower Colorado River Authority would

no longer co-sponsor and pay part of the costs of household hazardous waste disposal collection days in the county.

A representative of the agency, Kirk Scanlon, said the agency would provide planning assistance in determining the county's needs

and coming up with a plan.

One estimate of the cost of disposing of chemicals at a single collection day was about \$20,000.

Commissioner Tommy Hahn said since there was not money in the coming year's budget, it would be another year before the county should consider funding for a collection effort.

Commissioner Doug Wessels said if the county does not sponsor a collection day, it increases the chance of individuals dumping waste into ditches along roadways.

--Heard a presentation about new flood plain maps for the county.

Commissioners were told that because of a lack of funding from the Federal Emergency Management Agency, funds for providing new flood elevations cover only 21 of the 63 miles of the Colorado River in the county.

They were told the cost for calculating the elevations and placing them on maps for the remaining 42 miles would be about \$42,000.

They were told the flood elevations are used determine flood prone areas. In those areas, flood insurance is available, and there are usually building restrictions.

--Authorized construct of a replacement bridge on Old New Ulm Road at Redgate Creek, as an emergency, allowing an exemption on taking bids. Commissioner Tommy Hahn said the wooden bridge was closed and will be replaced.

Also, Commissioner Doug Wessels said a new bridge had just been finished on County Road 190 in his precinct new Provident City. He said the cost was \$257,000, with the county's portion being 10 percent.

However, both commissioners said that due to cuts in state funding, money from the state may not be available in the future.

--Approved proceeding with about \$6,500 in repairs to the old water tower on the Courthouse grounds that houses the Confederate Memorial Museum.

--Also approved accepting a

grant from the Macaulay Lantz Pavilion Foundation to help pay for the repairs.

--Accepted the resignation of William H. Wilson as the county's representative on the board of directors of the Central Appraisal District, effective Jan. 1.

--Discussed in closed session a personnel matter.
