

Houstonian Big Band Performing At Stafford

"It's time to swing out, Columbus!"

The Houstonian Big Band is pleased to be making a return to the historic 1886 Stafford Opera House in Columbus, for an evening performance on Saturday, Nov. 8, as part of the Dinner Theater schedule of events.

The social hour begins at 5:30 p.m., dinner is served at 6:30 p.m., and the music will begin at 7:30 p.m.

Listen and dance to many of the classic favorites from the big band era, such as the songs of Glenn Miller, Tommy Dorsey, Count Basie, Harry James, Artie Shaw and others.

"It is our goal to continue in the footsteps of the fine traditions of the classic big bands, and we truly feel lucky that our band continues to perform to this day," said Tom Viviano, lead trumpet for the band.

"We are thankful that so many folks love this music and that they enjoy seeing a traditional classic full-size big band."

Bob Antonoff, the band's drummer, added this.

Based in Houston, the Houstonian Big Band originated in 1977 and has played continuously since

that time.

This 12 to 15-piece group features an experienced conductor leading a traditional big band structure, including 4 woodwind players (saxophones/clarinet), 4 to 5 brass players (trumpets & trombones), a rhythm section (typically including drums, bass, guitar, piano), and a lead female vocalist.

Over the years, the band has performed for U.S. Presidents and senators, alumni associations, weddings and private parties, corporate functions, and many other special occasions.

Three of the original founding band members have been joined by many talented younger musicians who love big band music and desire to carry on the musical genre and tradition.

Band members have ranged in age from 20 to 80.

A large part of the band's musical repertoire came from an old trunk filled with big band arrangements from the thirties, forties and fifties, by such bands as Glenn Miller, Tommy Dorsey, Count Basie, Harry James, Artie Shaw and others.

If you like to hear Glenn Miller's orchestra playing "In The Mood", Tommy Dorsey playing "I'm Getting Sentimental Over You", Harry James' "You Made Me Love You", Artie Shaw's "Begin the Beguine", Count Basie's "April in Paris", or even Jimmy Lunsford's "For Dancers Only" or Ray Anthony's "Mr. A's Boogie", you'll love hearing the Houstonian Big Band and dancing to these tunes in person.

Egg Production Up Two Percent Over Last Year

September 2008 egg production in Texas totaled 403 million eggs, up 2 percent from September 2007 and down 1 percent from August 2008, according to the monthly report released by the Texas Field Office.

The number of layers during September averaged 18.6 million, down 1 percent from last year and up 1 percent from August 2008's 18.4 million.

Egg production per 100 layers averaged 2,165 eggs, up from last year's 2,101 eggs and down 2 percent from last month.

Texas hatchery production of broiler-type chicks totaled 54.7 million, up 3 percent from last year.

United States egg production totaled 7.34 billion eggs during September 2008, down 1 percent from a year ago.

Production included 6.28 billion table eggs, 990 million broiler-type hatching eggs and 65 million egg-type hatching eggs.

Nationally, the total number of layers averaged 334 million during September 2008, down 2 percent from a year ago.

Production per 100 layers was 2,194 eggs, up 1 percent from September 2007.

The U.S. monthly hatch of egg-type chicks totaled 36.4 million, up 3 percent from September 2007.

The hatch of broiler-type chicks, at 757 million, was down 3 percent from September of last year.

The leading U.S. breeders placed 6.89 million broiler-type pullet chicks for future domestic hatchery supply flocks during September 2008, down 6 percent from September 2007.

Level: Intermediate

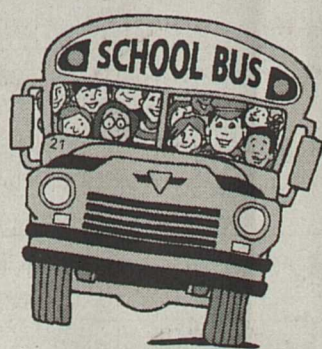
Here's How It Works:
