

# Rice Beats Schulenburg 42-14, Now 7-0

The Rice Raiders exorcised a few demons last Friday night when they beat Schulenburg 42-14 in Schulenburg.

The Raiders had lost to the Shorthorns the last two years, both times spoiling chances for undefeated regular seasons, something the Raiders have never accomplished.

The win also clenched a Division 1-AA Playoff spot for Rice. They will play Salado in bi-district on November 14 at 7:30 p.m. in Seguin.

Myles Dumont had another good performance for Rice with two touchdown passes on 15 of 20 passing for 225 yards. He also ran for one score.

Ziggy Foster had another solid night with 94 rushing yards and two touchdowns. He also had one catch for a 36-yard score.

Mario Hull had a big night with six catches for 96 yards and a touchdown.

The Raider defense had a good night again, holding Schulenburg scoreless until the six-minute mark of the fourth quarter.

The Raiders got the ball after an interception by Cody Lantelme on Schulenburg's first possession of the game.

Rice took over at the 43 and Dumont completed a pass to Hull for nine yards on the first play.

Foster picked up the first down on the next play with a three-yard run.

Two plays later, Dumont connected with Nick Duarte for seven yards, then Foster picked up another first down with a four yard carry to the Schulenburg 34.

In third down, Dumont hit J.J. Reggins for a 14-yard hit and a first down to the 23.

Foster then carried four straight downs to the Schulenburg five.

Dumont dropped back to pass and scrambled for a score after not finding a receiver.

He made the extra point for a 7-0 Rice lead with 1:35 left in the opening quarter.

Rice got the ball back after just two Shorthorn plays on a fumble recovery by Tanner Williams.

Rice took over at the Schulenburg 25, but was unable to capitalize and turned the ball over on downs after four plays.

Schulenburg drove the ball

all the way to the Raider 17 on the ensuing possession, but the defense stood strong and Schulenburg attempted a field goal and missed.

The Raiders went on a long drive to burn up most of the remaining time in the half, but were unable to get any points.

The half ended with the score 7-0.

Rice got the ball to start the second half, and went right to work.

Foster broke loose for 31 yards, but the play was called back on offsetting penalties.

A few plays later, Dumont connected with Hull for 28 yards to the Schulenburg 23.

On the next play, Dumont threw to Hull again, this time for a 23-yard score.

Dumont made the extra point for a 14-0 lead with 8:51 left in the third.

Schulenburg got the ball at the 29 to start their next drive, and ran the ball 10 straight times to the Rice 36.

Two plays later, the Raider defense held on a fourth and seven try, giving the ball back to the offense at the Rice 33.

The first play was a pass to Reggins for eight yards.

Foster followed with a one-yard gain. Dumont kept the ball for 19 yards on the next play, pushing to the Schulenburg 35.

Foster got the ball on the next play and broke through to the secondary. He broke a tackle at the 10-yard line and rambled the rest of the way to the endzone.

The Raiders got a two-point conversion on the ole swinging gate play. The ball was snapped to Chris Dorsey, who ran straight ahead for the two points.

The Raider lead was 22-0 with 1:01 left in the third.

The Raider defense forced a Schulenburg three and out on the next series and Rice got the ball at the 50 after the punt.

Foster carried for 12 yards on the first play to the 38.

Dumont hit Marques Toliver for nine on the next play.

Next, he threw complete to Duarte for 21 to the eight-yard line.

Dumont kept the ball for six, before Foster punched in for the touchdown from the two.

Dumont made the extra point, and the lead was 29-0 with 8:53 left in the game.

Eric Gold recovered a muffed kick for the Raiders and they set up at the 35.

Dumont found Foster wide open out of the backfield and he took it 35 yards for the score on the first play.

Dumont made the extra point for a 36-0 lead with 8:37 on the clock.

A Schulenburg player was injured on the ensuing kickoff and the game was delayed about 25 minutes before he was taken from the field on a stretcher. The young man was reportedly released from the hospital early the next morn-

ing and is going to be fine.

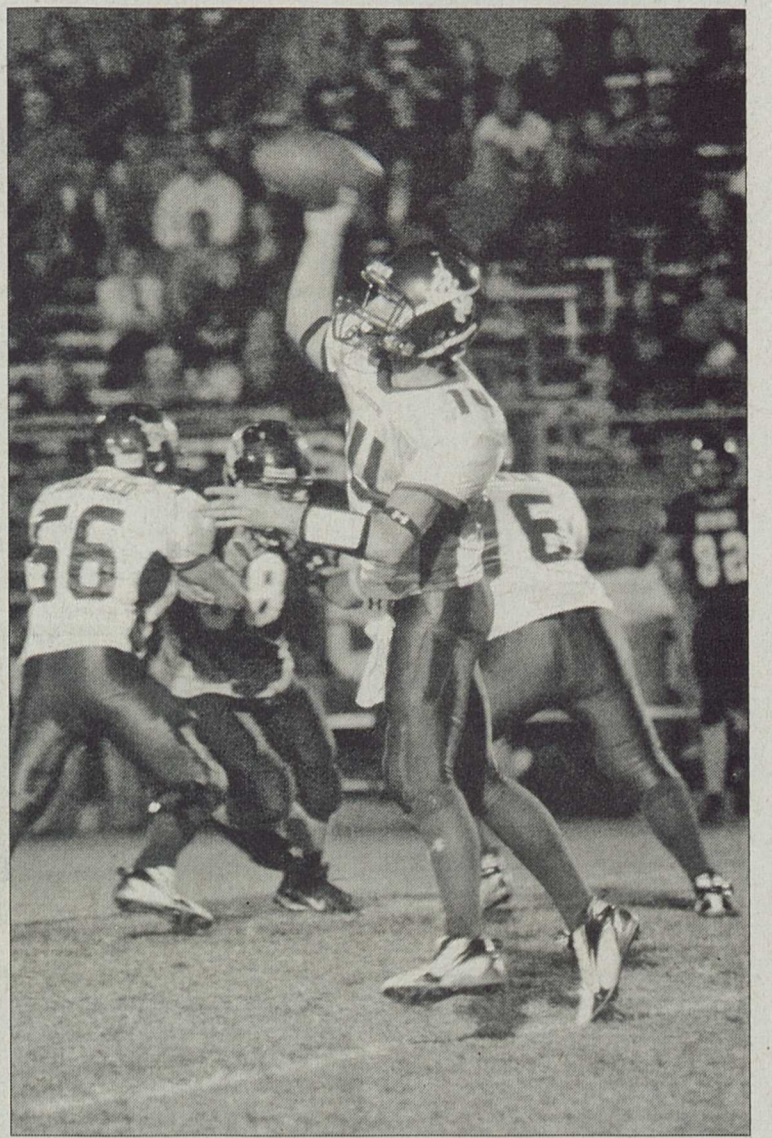
The Shorthorns went down the field after the game resumed and score their first touchdown.

## Raiders Host Hempstead Friday

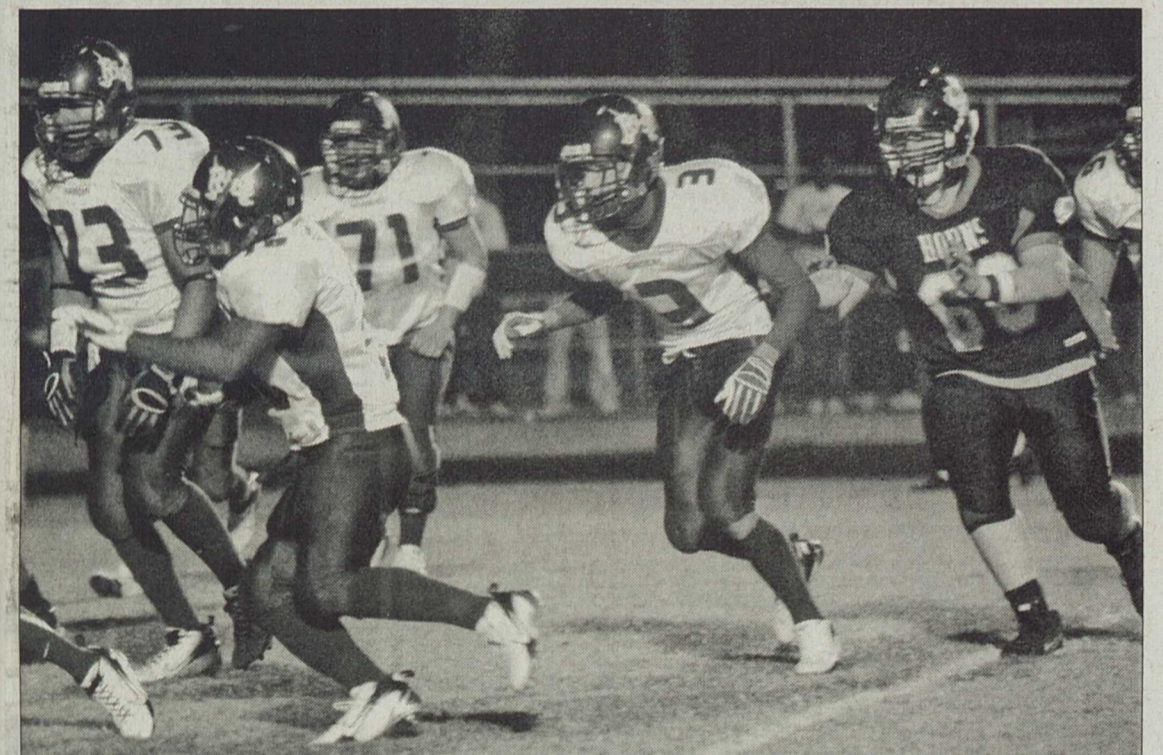
The Rice Raiders take on Hempstead in Altair on Homecoming night this Friday.
