

2008-2009 Daily Bag and Possession Limits

Bag and Possession Limits for Geese

Bag Limit: Western Zone Daily Bag Limit:

Light Geese - 20 in the aggregate;

Dark Geese - 4 Canada and 1 white-fronted goose.

Eastern Zone Daily Bag Limit: Light Geese - 20 in the aggregate; 3 Canada geese and 2 White-fronted geese.

Possession Limit: Twice the daily bag limit for dark geese, no possession limit for light geese.

DUCK DAILY BAG LIMIT:

The daily bag limit shall be 5 ducks with the following species and sex restrictions - two scaup, two redhead, and two wood duck; only one from the following aggregate bag: one hen mallard, or one pintail, or one canvasback, or one "dusky duck" (mottled duck, Mexican-like duck, black duck, and their hybrids); all other ducks not listed - five.

MERGANSE DAILY BAG LIMIT: Five in the aggregate, to include no more than two hooded mergansers.

COOT DAILY BAG LIMIT: 15

POSSESSION LIMIT: The possession limit for ducks, coots and mergansers is twice the daily bag limit.

FAYETTE - White-tailed Deer Archery Only: September 27-October 31, 2008. No permit required to hunt antlerless deer unless MLD permits have been issued for the property.

General Season: November 1, 2008-January 4, 2009. Buck bag limit: 2, to include no more than one with an inside spread of 13 inches or greater. A legal buck deer is a

deer having at least one unbranched antler, or an inside spread of 13 inches or greater. The inside spread requirement does not apply to any buck having an unbranched antler. These provisions do not apply on properties for which Level 2 or Level 3 MLDPs have been issued.

Antlerless bag limit: 2, by antlerless permit only.

Special Youth-Only Season: Early open season: October 25-26, 2008. Late open season: January 17-18, 2009.

Bag limits, provision for the

take of antlerless deer, and special requirements of the county, shall be as specified for the first 2 days of the general open season.

Licensed hunters 16 years of age or younger may hunt deer by any lawful means during this season.

Squirrel: no closed season. No bag limit.

Turkey The annual bag limit for Rio Grande and Eastern turkey, in the aggregate for all counties, is four (4), no more than one of which may be an Eastern turkey. For counties that have an Eastern

Turkey spring season, there is no fall season.

Spring: Rio Grande turkey: Open season: April 1-30, 2009. Bag limit: 1 gobbler.

Quail: Statewide: Open season: October 25, 2008-February 22, 2009. Daily bag limit: 15 Possession limit: 45

COLORADO: White-tailed Deer

Archery Only: September 27-October 31, 2008. No permit required to hunt antlerless deer unless MLD permits have been issued

for the property.

General Season: November 1, 2008-January 4, 2009. Buck bag limit: 2, to include no more than one with an inside spread of 13 inches or greater. A legal buck deer is a deer having at least one unbranched antler, or an inside spread of 13 inches or greater. The inside spread requirement does not apply to any buck having an unbranched antler. 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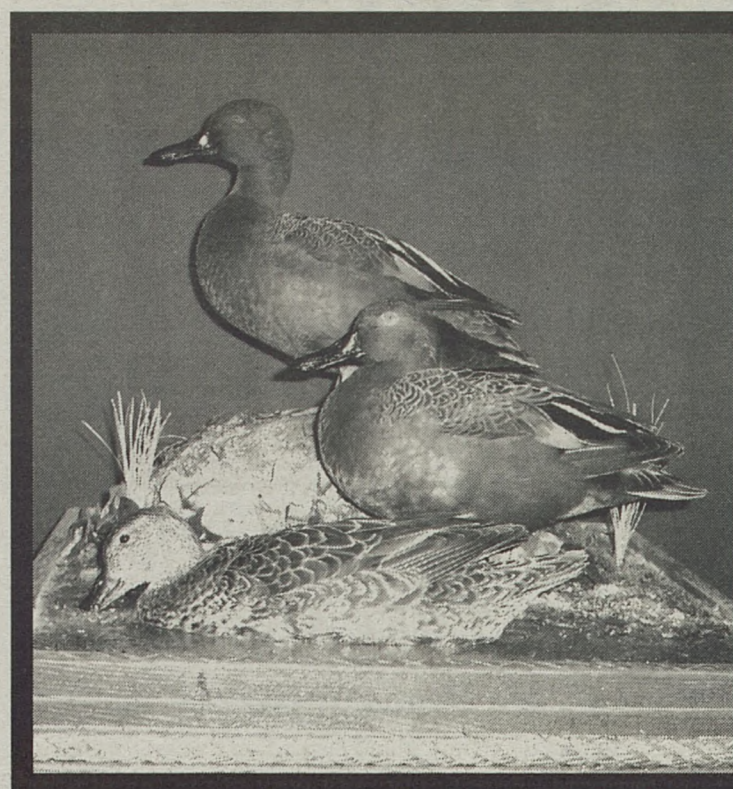
