

# Schwemms Offer Hunting Accommodations

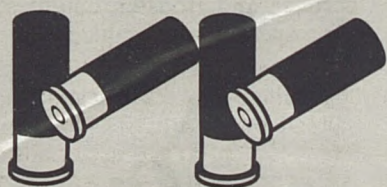
The Sportsman's Hunting Lodge is located 1-1/2 miles north of Eagle Lake, "The Goose Hunting Capital of the World."
