The sessions will be held 5:30-7 p.m. in rooms 120 and 121 of the Liberal Arts Building at 100 Ranger Drive.

The transition option allows LVNs to complete the Associate Degree Nursing (ADN) course requirements in one calendar year and to apply to the take the national licensing exam to become a Registered Nurse (RN).

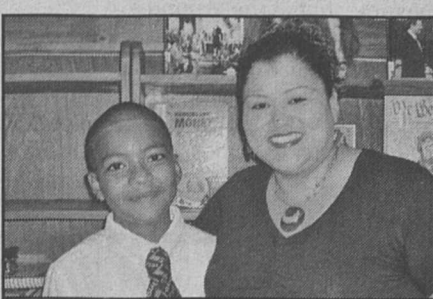
