Deep in the Heart of Texas.

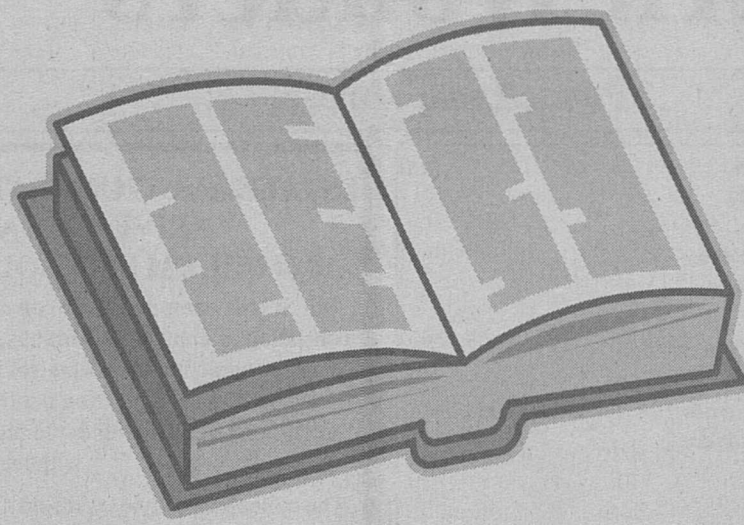
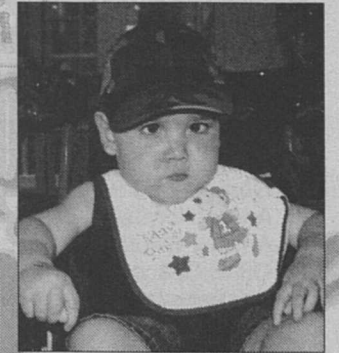

At 9:05 pm, Deputy Gonzalez responded to Old McDonald Lane in reference to criminal mischief. A report was filed and the case is pending further information.

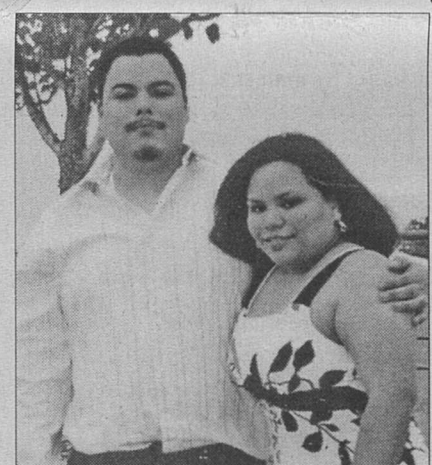
