LCRA To San Antonio Water In Doubt

Preliminary results from a multi-year study of a proposed joint water-sharing project between the Lower Colorado River Authority and the San Antonio Water System (SAWS) show that the project, as designed, would not generate enough water to meet all legislative and contractual requirements.

The major implication of the preliminary study results is that no water can be made available to SAWS from the project as it was originally envisioned.

"LCRA continues to work with SAWS staff to explore options," said LCRA General Manager Tom Mason.

"We are brainstorming to see what we can do, within the legislative terms that have been provided to us."

"LCRA continues to work with SAWS to understand the implications of this new data and to decide how best to move forward."

LCRA and SAWS signed a contract in 2002 to study the feasibility of a water-sharing project to determine if the project could provide for water needs in both basins while meeting requirements set by the Texas Legislature.

The major shortfall in the lower Colorado River basin identified by the regional water-planning group (Region K) is water for agricultural irrigation.

Legislative requirements passed in 2001 include that the project must protect and benefit the lower Colorado River basin's interests, be consistent with the state's public planning process, ensure the health of Matagorda Bay, maintain necessary river flow protections and raise the average levels of lakes Travis and Buchanan higher than they would be otherwise.

Various factors influence the preliminary study findings, including updated projections for municipal and industrial water needs in the lower Colorado River basin and environmental study findings.

In the next 50 to 90 years, between 14 and 25 percent more water is needed than was projected in the 2006 regional water plan.

Environmental study findings also show that more water is needed for the lower Colorado River and bays and estuaries.

The world famous Ace in the Hole band country music at its best, admission only \$10.

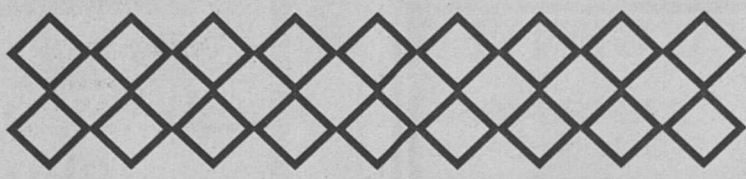
