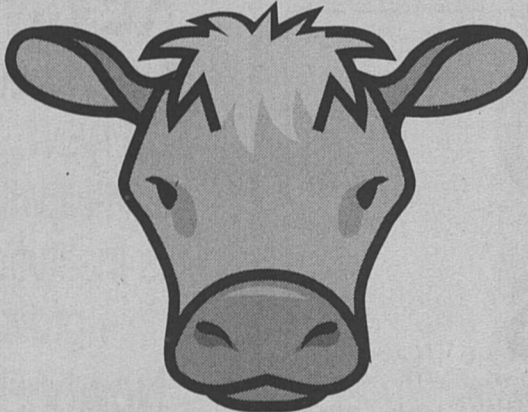

### DRY MOUTH

Many medications - including painkillers, diuretics, anti-hypertensives, anti-depressants, and antihistamines - can cause dry mouth; so can hormonal changes associated with pregnancy or menopause, as well as stress and diabetes. For some people, dry mouth is simply uncomfortable, but for others, the condition can lead to tooth decay and bad breath.

With less saliva, there may be higher levels of bacteria and plaque in your mouth, which can cause decay around the teeth.

**FIX IT:** Increasing fluid intake can sometimes help. Similarly, chewing sugar-free gum or sucking on sugar-free candy may stimulate saliva flow. If dry mouth triggers bad breath, be sure to brush the back of your tongue, as well as the roof of your mouth to clean out all bacteria on a daily basis. If these measures don't seem to help, talk to your dentist and medical physician.
