

## Swine Flu Information

The symptoms of Swine Flu are similar to the symptoms of regular seasonal flu, and include fever, cough, sore throat, body ache, headache, chills and fatigue.

If you have these symptoms, you are more likely to have the regular flu than Swine Flu.

Swine flu is a respiratory disease of pigs caused by the Type A Influenza virus that causes outbreaks in pigs.

People do not normally get Swine Flu, but human infections can happen.

Influenza is thought to spread mainly person-to-person through coughing or sneezing of infected people.

There is no transmission by ingesting of pork.

There is no reason to think you can get the Swine Flu from eating pork.

There are things you can do to stay healthy and minimize the spread of any flu:

-Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when you cough or sneeze.

Throw the tissue in the trash after you use it.

-Wash your hands often with soap and water, especially after you cough or sneeze.

Alcohol-based hands cleaners are also effective.

--Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth.

Germs spread that way.

If you get sick, the Centers for Disease Control recommends that you stay home from work or school and limit contact with others to keep from infecting them.

Medications are reserved for seasonal flu and confirmed cases of Swine Flu.

"I met with the medical community officials of Colorado County on April 27," Campbell said.

"We are responding with heightened alertness to this health threat.

"We have an emergency plan in place, should there be an outbreak of Swine Flu.

"For prudence, we have instituted some preventative measures in the hospitals, emergency rooms and ambulance services.

"We are closely monitoring the situation with the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and Texas Department of State and Health Services (TDSHS)."

Updates will be provided through the local newspapers, radio and the local cable public access channel.
