COLORADO COUNTY COURTHOUSE REPORT

Thirty-Five Sentenced In County Court

Thirty-five individuals were sentenced in Colorado County Court on Wednesday, May 6. They included:

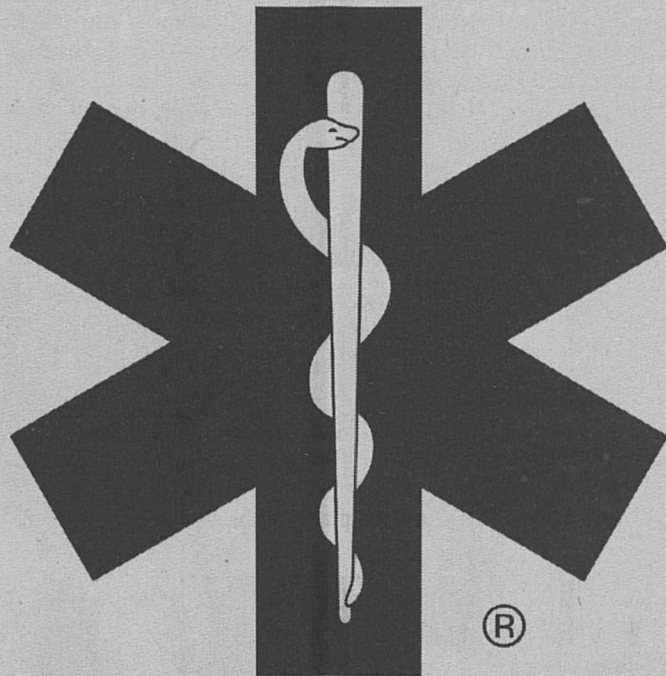
