USDA Announces Rural Cooperative Grants

USDA Rural Development Acting State Director Scooter Brockett announced May 5 that the agency is accepting applications for the Rural Cooperative Development Grant (RCDG) Program for Fiscal Year 2009 as published in the April 29 Federal Register.

Applications will compete nationwide.

The RCDG Program fosters rural cooperative development through projects that provide rural residents with education and technical assistance in areas of cooperative startup, marketing and managing and other self-help tools.

The grants are available to nonprofit corporations and institutions of higher education.

The maximum award per grant is \$200,000 and matching funds are required.

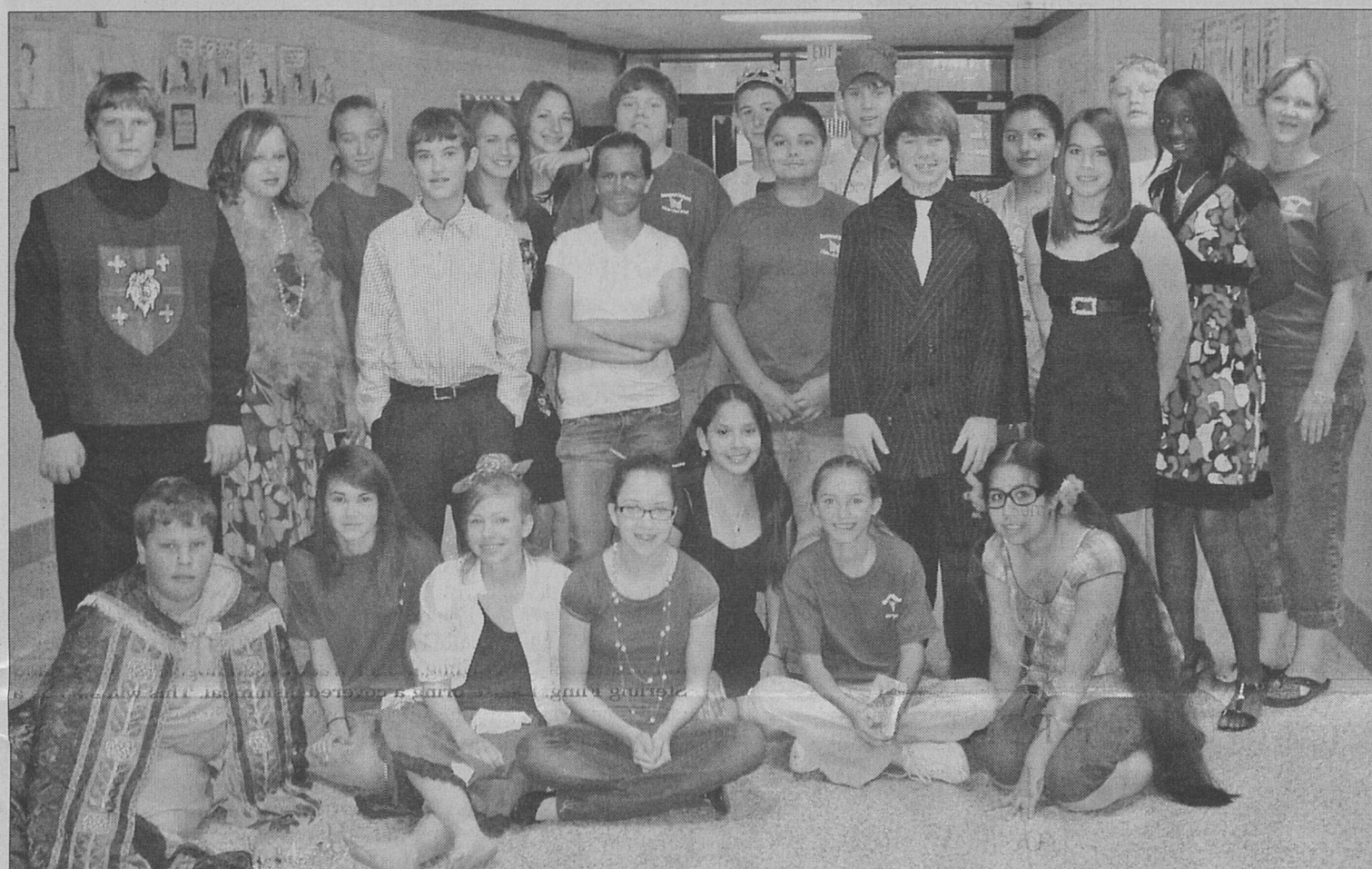

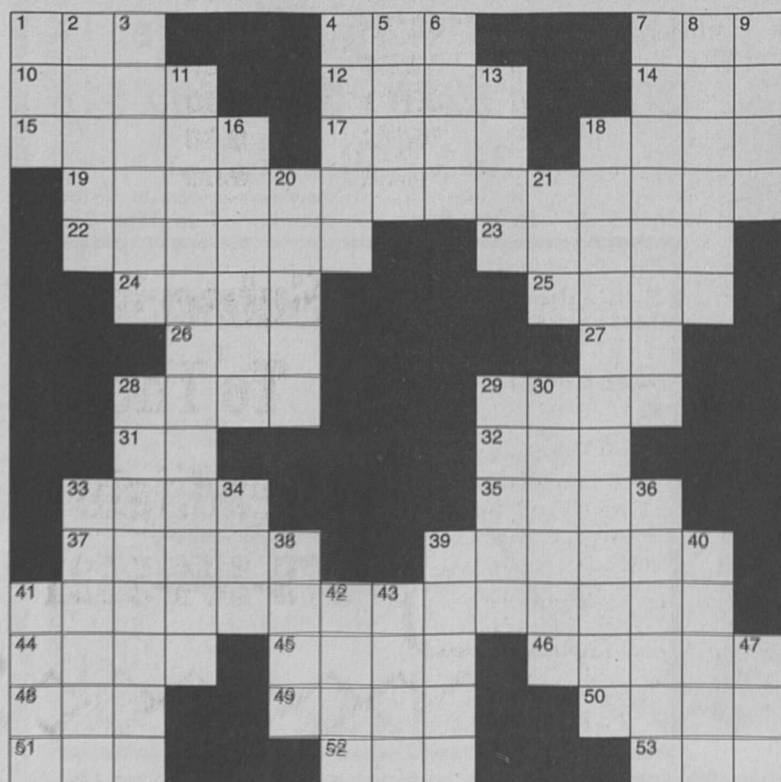

Commissioners also awarded a bid to construct a new bridge on Lutonsky Road at Stein Creek in Precinct 3 to Wakefield Bridge Inc. on a bid of \$109,000.

In other action, commissioners accepted a \$1,200 check for local residents in support of the Colorado County Civil Air Patrol.

They also heard a presentation on a change in procedures needed to account for retirees' health insurance, although the county does not pay for retirees' health insurance.

A resolution of appreciation was also issued to Dale Rankin, who recently left his position as county extension agent to take a similar position in another county.
