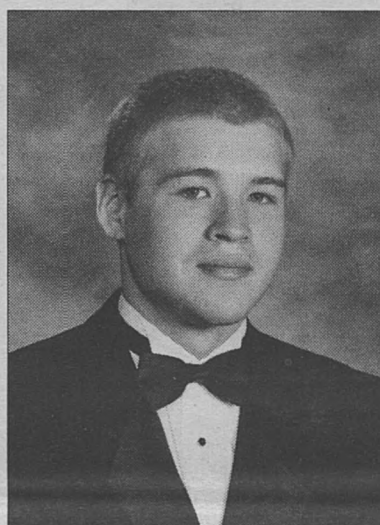

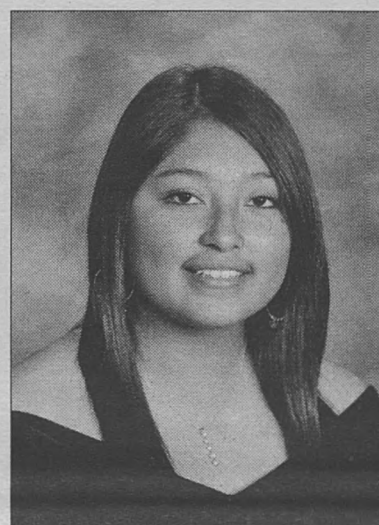


**Garreth Casper

After graduation he plans to major in Bio-Chemical Engineering at Texas A&M University, and pursue a career in clean and renewable energy sources.

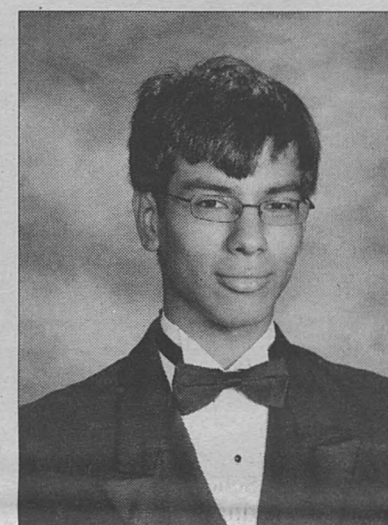


**Sabara Saenz
