Ridge received money, picture frames, a bible, a rosary and many other gifts.

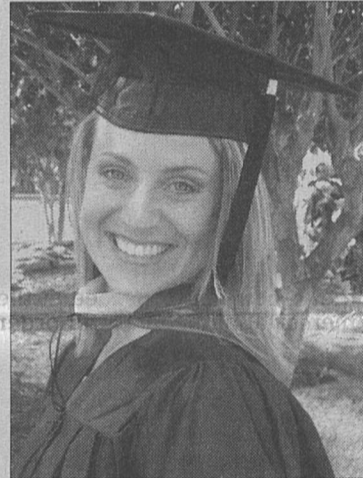
## LCRA Donates To Library


