Q. My baby has a fever and a touch of diarrhea. Is that because he's teething?
Some pediatricians don't buy into the idea that these symptoms are related to teething, but others see a connection. The usual scenario is that a parent will bring in an irritable 6-month old with a low-grade fever (less than 100.5) and some mild diarrhea. The child is also drooling and chewing on his fingers or anything else near his mouth. An exam doesn't show any problem, and the parent is sent home with instructions for managing the fever. Then, two or three days later, a new tooth appears—and soon after that the fever and diarrhea disappear. A good rule of thumb is that whatever problem you think is due to teething should pass without treatment within 24 hours. If it doesn't, your baby may actually be sick with something else and should be seen by his pediatrician.
