



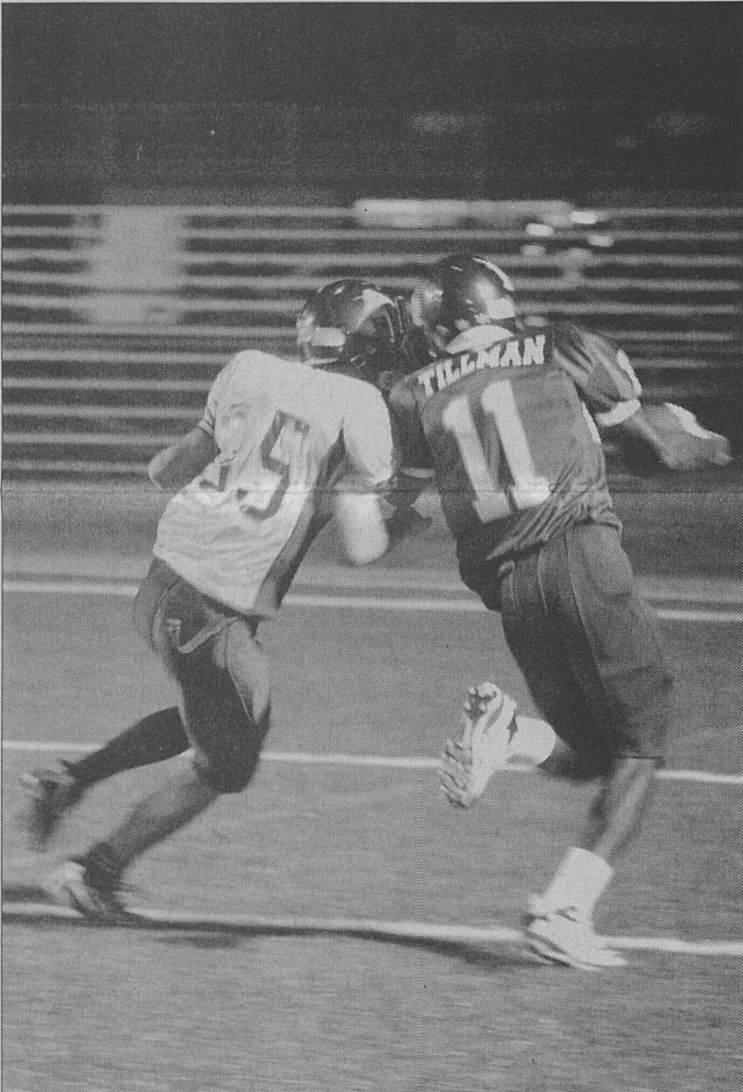

halftime.

The Raider defense once again forced a three and out on the next drive, but Freer inexplicably tried a fake punt on fourth and 19 from their own 11.

The throw attempt fell incomplete and the Raiders made short work of the very short field, scoring three plays later on a one-yard Scott carry.

Samaniego made the point after for a 34-0 lead with 6:37 left in the half.

The Raider defense, for the fourth straight possession, forced a three and out and a poor punt gave Rice the ball at the 32.

Tillman broke the first play for a touchdown, aided by a block on the end of the line to free him by Kevin Ellis.

Samaniego made the extra point for a 41-0 lead with 3:32 left

in the half.

Freer held the ball to the end of the half.

Rice got the ball to start the second half and Scott took the kickoff back 89 yards for a touchdown.

After the extra point by Samaniego, it was 48-0 with 11:42 left in the third.

On Freer's second play, Cody

Lantelme recovered a fumble and returned it 15-yards for another touchdown. Samaniego hit the extra point for a 55-0 lead with 10:17 remaining in the third.

Rice added one more score just after the start of the fourth quarter on a 48-yard run by Ellis. A two-point try failed, and the score was 61-0, which was also the final score.
