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THC Award Nominations Sought

Have you been following a journalist committed to preserving the historic resources in your community? Did you just finish a book exploring the significance of Texas history?

Consider nominating these accomplishments for one of the Texas Historical Commission's (THC) two prestigious awards—the Award of Excellence in Media Achievement and the T.R. Fehrenbach Book Award.

The Award of Excellence in Media Achievement serves to increase awareness of Texas' historic and prehistoric resources by promoting outstanding reporting through print or electronic media on preservation and/or heritage tourism issues.

Past winners include Irene Van Winkle of the West Kerr Current, whose articles on the pioneering families of Kerr County ultimately resulted in a book and Mike Snyder of the Houston Chronicle, who focused on the Old Sixth Ward historic district near downtown Houston.

Nominations for the Award of Excellence in Media Achievement must be received no later than 5 p.m. on Dec. 11, 2009.

The T.R. Fehrenbach Book Award, named in honor of historian and THC Commissioner Emeritus T.R. Fehrenbach, recognizes writing based on original research that preserve, record and recount the prehistory or history of the state.

Books submitted for the award must have a 2009 copyright date and a minimum print run of 200. Nominations are due by Dec. 31, 2009 at 5 p.m. Up to three awards will be presented.

Both awards will be announced during the THC's 2010 Annual Historic Preservation Conference held April 22-24 in Houston.

Reason: Being blinded by an oncoming vehicle with one headlight in the ditch and the other in the lane of oncoming vehicle.

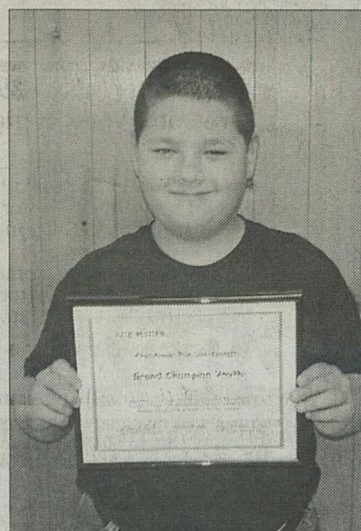
3.) We support that any com-
