TDA Market Recap

For the week ending Nov. 28, feeder cattle prices at Texas auctions were steady to \$5 higher per hundredweight in very light holiday-week trade.

Many locations were closed for the week so demand was somewhat higher for the limited offerings.

Fed cattle prices also increased as processors began lining up supplies for after the holiday.

Cotton prices ended the week higher as concerns about the crop in the southeastern U.S. and improved global demand continue to support the market.

As for futures markets, corn and lumber were higher while feeder cattle, finished cattle, cotton and wheat were lower.

Parts of South Central Texas and the Coastal Bend recorded up to two inches of rain during

the week, but most other areas of the state received little or no rainfall.

Topsoil moisture was rated mostly adequate to short statewide.

Cotton harvest made good progress thanks to favorable weather on the Plains and now stands at 83 percent complete, well ahead of the 68 percent average.

Grain sorghum harvest was slightly ahead of normal at 94 percent complete.

Winter wheat planting progressed to 94 percent complete with 84 percent of the acreage emerged.

The crop was reported in mostly good to fair condition.

Pastures continue to decline with the shorter days and cooler temperatures.

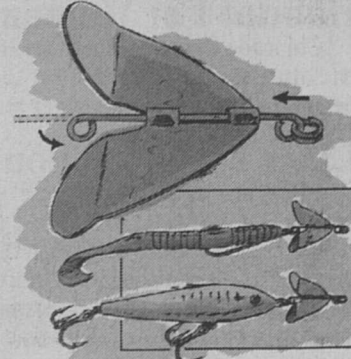
Fishin' Tip

"If you're like most anglers and are constantly looking to try something new or add something to your other lures, here's a good idea to cause a lot of commotion at your next hotspot."

"Take the buzzbait and run a piece of small diameter steel rod through the hole of the buzzbait. Next, bend both ends of the rod into loops. Now, add a snap swivel or a split ring to one end. Finally, you're ready to add any lure from a worm rig to a stick bait. Give it a try and this modified buzzbait will quickly become one of your favorite lures."
