At 10 pm, Sgt. Nelson was dispatched to an unwanted person at the Barn. Case closed by the issuance of a criminal trespass warning.

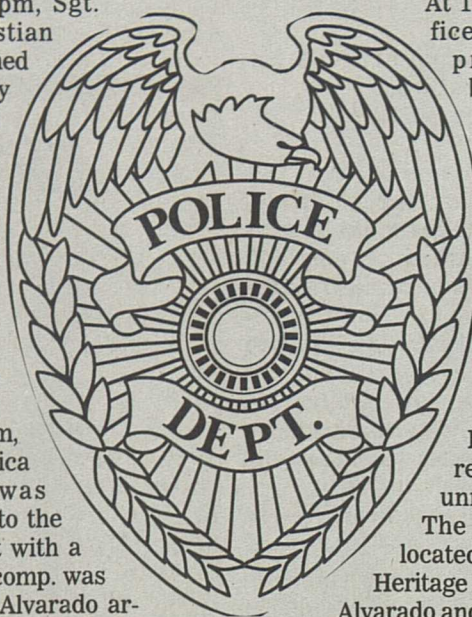
At 10:22 pm, Officer Gonzales was dispatched to shots being fired at the intersection of Burns and Willow Streets. The described activity was not located.
