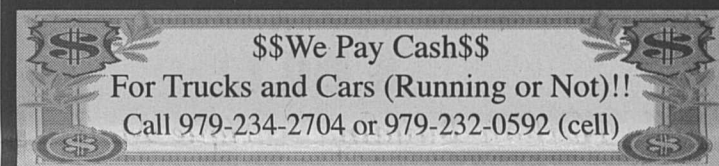

Woman Acquitted Of Drunken Driving Charges

A Colorado County Court jury returned a verdict of not guilty in a driving while intoxicated case on December 10, 2009 following a one and a half day trial.

On July 9, 2009 Colorado County Sheriff Sgt. Marc Staff arrested Dodie Vogler, 42, of Boling, after completing an investigation for driving while intoxicated.

The Deputy did not see the defendant driving her vehicle. She was found parked on County Road 101 south of the Robert R. Wells, Jr. airport, asleep behind the wheel of her vehicle with the motor running.

She did admit at the scene of the investigation that she had driven from Bastrop to where she was found parked.

During the trial, the defen-

dant took the witness stand and admitted to consuming two beers during her drive from Bastrop to Columbus and two margaritas at Los Cabos restaurant in Columbus, where she ate dinner.

She also testified she realized shortly after leaving the restaurant that she was not fit to drive and pulled over to park, only four miles from the restaurant.

After the verdict, one of the jurors indicated that they found her not guilty since she had been parked and not driving when the Deputy encountered her and did not believe that she was intoxicated when she was driving.

Vogler was represented by Leonard E. Peters of Columbus.
