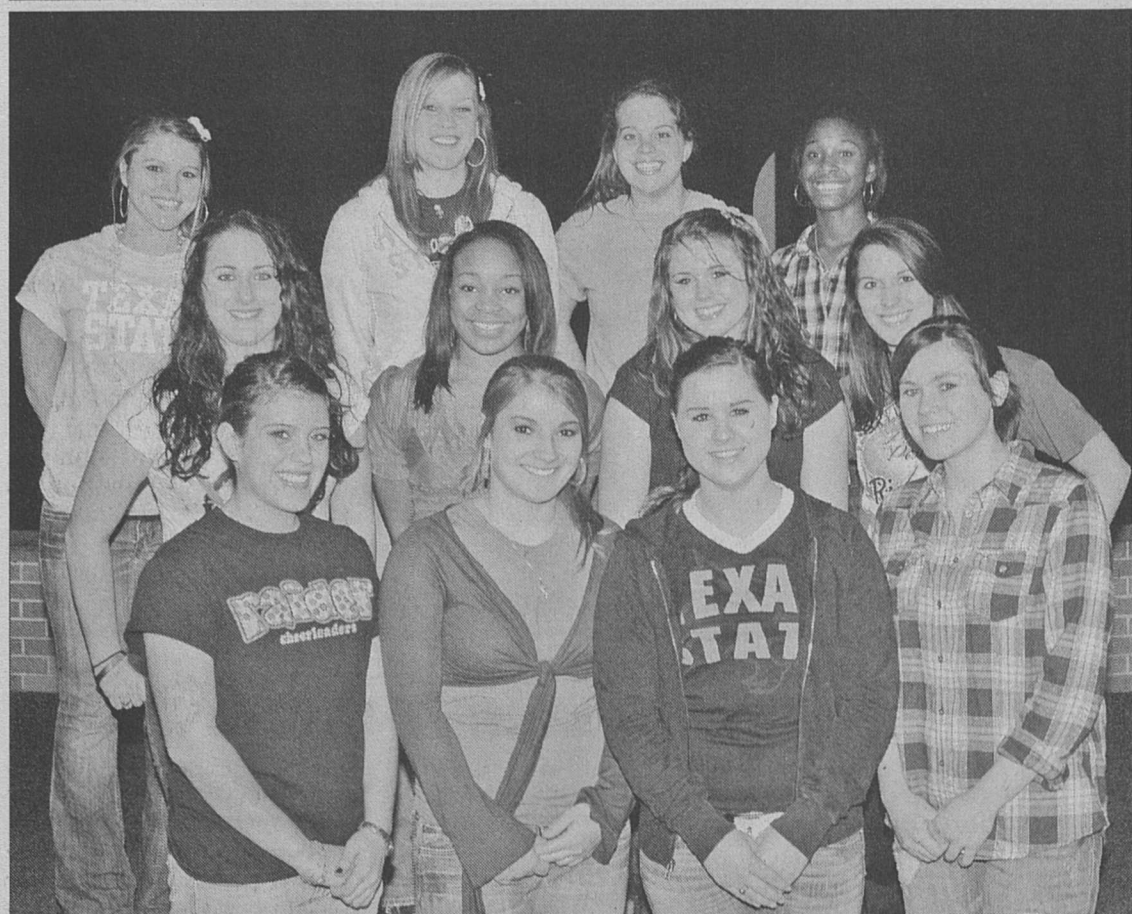

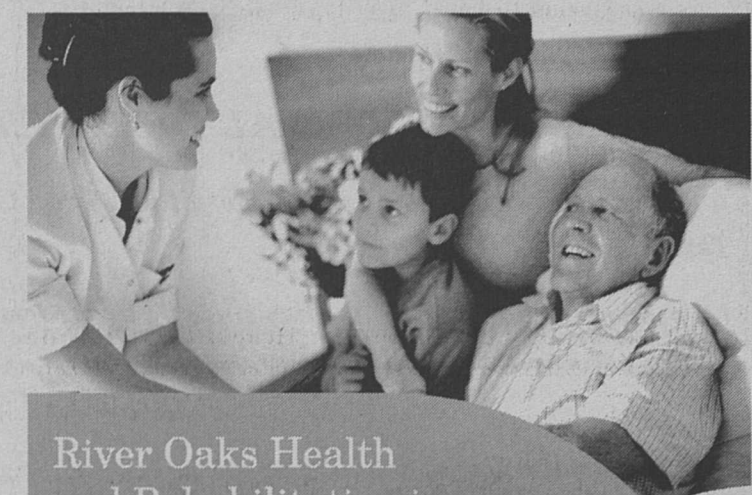
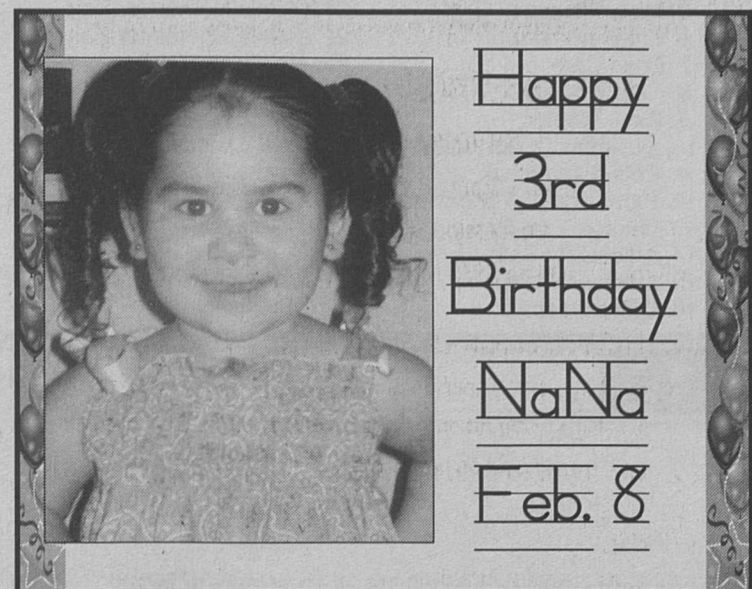
The Rice Raider Varsity basketball team fell to the Weimar Wildcats, 58-67 on Friday, Jan. 29.
