The Team will be competing in the San Marcos High School Invitational Golf Tournament on February 22th , held in San Marcos, at Quail Creek Country Club.

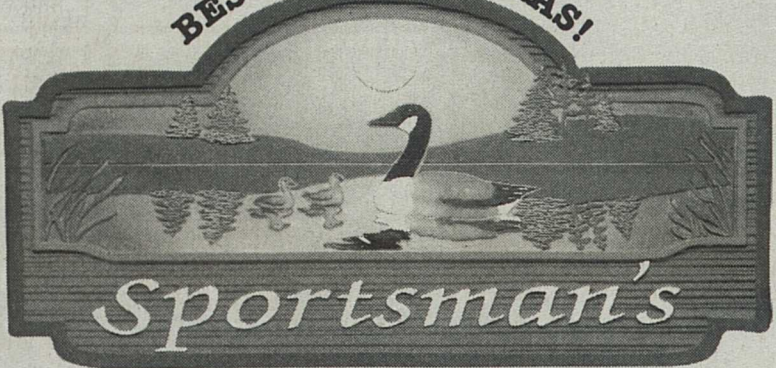
