With the help of several other conservation minded individuals, I organized numerous youth hunts on our family's property plus trips to South Texas on ranches I was involved in managing.

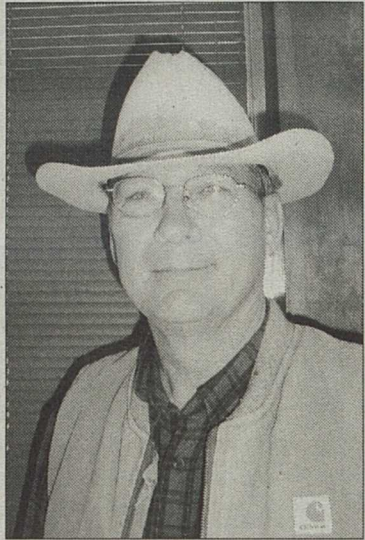
This opportunity introduced dozens of eager young children and their guardians to the sport of hunting that do not normally have the chance to experience the outdoors.
