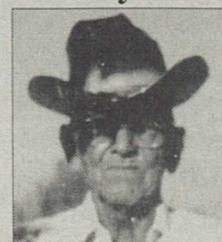
At 6:56 pm, Sgt. Nelson was dispatched to the 500 block of Sixth St. in regards to a parking problem. The matter was settled at the scene.

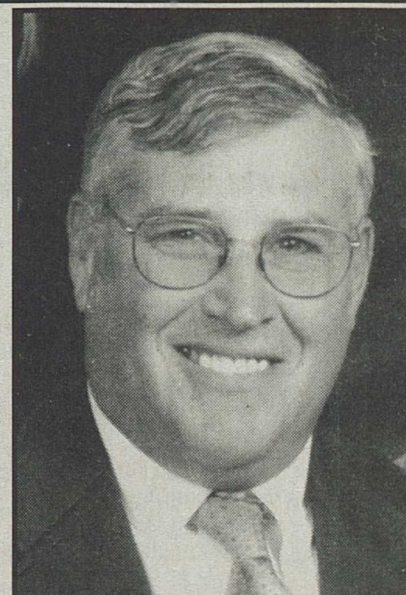
