At 11:43 pm, Officer Alvarado was dispatched to the 1300 block of Murphy St. in regards to a welfare concern. All was found to be in order.

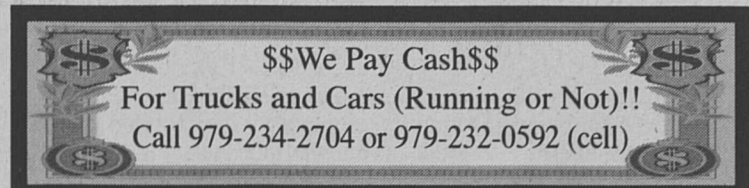
