Director Vacancy – Place 6 Colorado County Groundwater Conservation District

The Colorado County Groundwater Conservation District is accepting applications for a Board of Directors seat recently vacated. The District is seeking a director to fill the Place 6 seat.

Director Jim Wiese resigned from the Board effective February 16, 2010, due to his relocation outside of Eagle Lake city limits. Wiese's term expires in November 2010.

Colorado County citizens are eligible to serve on the district board if they reside within the city limits of Eagle Lake, are registered to vote in Colorado County and are 18 years of age or older.

The CCGCD Board of Directors will interview candidates and make a selection at a future meeting date. The final candidate will be appointed to the board to fill Wiese's position until the next election in November 2010, when the voters will elect a director for Place 6.

The City of Eagle Lake will receive bids for the 2009 TCDP Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements, OE Job No. 22.055-SA/SB, TxCDBG Contract Number R729130 until 2:00 P.M. on April 6, 2010 at the City of Eagle Lake, 100 E. Main, Eagle Lake, Texas 77434-0038. The bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the same time and place.

Bids are invited for several items and quantities of work as follows:

1. Replace existing blowers with 2 each 100 Hp positive displacement blowers for the existing aeration basin.
2. Replace 18 each 1" air diffuser drops for the existing aeration basin.
3. Install new galvanized steel access bridge for the existing aeration basin.
4. Replace existing sludge drying ramp plates with new stainless steel ramp plates and new pressure treated seal boards.
5. Install new chain link cantilevered entry gate with automatic opener.
